Who?	<p>Students in grade 9-12 who failed an English, Math, Science, Social Studies, or Spanish class with at least a 50. If a student has BELOW the qualifying mark of 50 in any subject and wishes to attend summer school, THEY MUST PROVIDE A LETTER OF APPEAL ALONG WITH THIS APPLICATION. The letter should be addressed to the OHS Administration/Director of Summer School. We will send the final grade to our current school.</p> <p>Non OHS Student: Must have approval(written letter or email) from own school to attend.</p>
When?	<p>June 29th - July 17th. {No School on July 3 }</p> <p>Summer School courses will be divided into two sessions once registration is complete. Once a student is registered, they will be informed of the session.</p> <p>Session 1: 8:00-10:00 Session 2: 10:00-12:00</p> <p>Please note that only one absence will be allowed before a student loses credit in Summer School. Two tardies to class equals one absence. Students will be marked tardy up to the first 15 minutes, and anything beyond the 15 an absence will be given. Please also note that the policies found in the 2025-2026 Oxford High School Student Handbook will be strictly adhered to for the duration of Summer School.</p>
Where?	<p>Oxford High School, 100 Carbuncle Drive, Oxford, MA 01540</p> <p>Transportation to and from summer school will be the family's responsibility.</p>
How Much?	<p>Current OPS Students: Cost for summer school is \$150 per course and \$50 for each additional course. A reduced rate is available for students already deemed eligible for free/reduced lunch benefits. Checks should be made payable to "Town of Oxford".</p> <p>Non OHS Student Rate: \$200 for 1 class; \$350 for 2 classes</p>
