Thursday, June 4: Social Studies and World Language

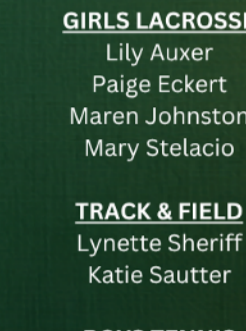
