### *Student Transportation*

Community School staff transport McKinney-Vento students to ensure they can stay in their school of origin, promoting stability and access to education for those experiencing homelessness.

### *Wellness Space Access*

1,678

Students using wellness spaces at school receive support for mental and emotional health, with counseling, relaxation areas, and mindfulness activities to help them cope and improve well-being.

### *MTSS Referrals*

Students referred through MTSS receive targeted interventions for academic, behavioral, or social-emotional challenges, ensuring early support and success.

### *Check and Connect*

The Check and Connect system has Community School Liaisons check in weekly with McKinney-Vento students to monitor their well-being, academic progress, and connect them to resources, ensuring continued school engagement despite housing instability.
