DRIVING AND PARKING REGULATIONS

To register your vehicle for a parking pass, you must provide the following:

1. A current student ID
2. A valid Arizona Drivers License*
3. An Arizona vehicle registration in the name of the student or the student's parent(s)/guardian(s)*
4. Vehicle insurance in the name of the student or student's parent(s)/guardian(s)
5. \$2.00 Parking Fee – payable in the Bookstore

**STUDENTS WILL ONLY BE ISSUED ONE (1) PARKING STICKER PER VEHICLE.
REPLACEMENTS WILL BE AT STUDENT COST.**

*In some cases, vehicle registrations/drivers licenses from other states will be accepted for students who can prove migrant status, family military status, or who are paying out-of-state tuition. The Administrator in charge of parking will handle these on a case-by-case basis.

Driving through campus, excessive speed, reckless driving, parking or driving in bus lanes, and parking in driveways or emergency exits is prohibited at ALL times. Violators are subject to disciplinary action and/or towing.

Any violation of the parking regulations may result in having parking privileges revoked for a period to be determined by the number and/or severity of the violations. Violations will be reported to the Administration Office.

PARKING REGULATIONS

1. Student parking sections are filled on a first-come, first-served basis.
2. Once parked, students must not return to their vehicles during the school day until it is time for students to leave campus.
3. Students may not park in visitor parking, reserved (staff) parking, or along curbs, bus lanes, or sidewalks.
4. Students must park in one parking space only.
5. The parking sticker is issued to a specific person and a specific vehicle and **MUST BE PERMANENTLY AFFIXED** to the lower driver's side of the windshield where it can easily be seen by security.
6. Temporary parking pass – A one-time temporary pass will be issued to a student for 5 school days if the student needs to drive an alternate vehicle to school. This pass can be renewed as needed.
7. On-campus driving regulations are covered in the Student Handbook and must be followed.
8. The school is not responsible for vehicles driven or parked on campus. Students, their parent(s)/guardian(s), and vehicle owners assume the responsibility for loss or damage to vehicles or contents while parked on campus. Always lock your vehicle.
9. The interior of student vehicles may be inspected whenever a school authority has reason to believe that illegal or unauthorized materials may be contained inside. Such patrols and inspections may be conducted without notice, without student consent, and without a search warrant.
10. Lost stickers will be replaced for a two-dollar (\$2) charge, payable in the Bookstore.

Acknowledge and understand that:

- A. Students are permitted to park on school premises as a matter of privilege, not of right.
- B. The District retains authority to conduct routine patrols of student parking lots and inspections of the exteriors of student automobiles on school property.
- C. The District may inspect the interiors of student automobiles whenever a school authority has reasonable suspicion to believe that illegal or unauthorized materials are contained inside the automobiles.
- D. Such patrols and inspections may be conducted without notice, without student consent, and without a search warrant.
- E. A student who fails to provide access to the interior of the car upon request by a school official will be subject to school disciplinary action.
- F. If the student fails to follow school policy and procedure related to use of vehicles, the vehicle may be towed away and stored, at the owner's expense.

Furthermore, I understand student/staff parking requires that vehicles be registered at school and regulations be followed. I have reviewed the complete listing of regulations and understand that on-campus parking may be suspended for violations of on-campus driving and parking regulations.

Any vehicle while on campus is subject to search if it is determined the vehicle may contain items that are harmful to students and/or staff. Refusal for search could result in disciplinary action including suspension.
