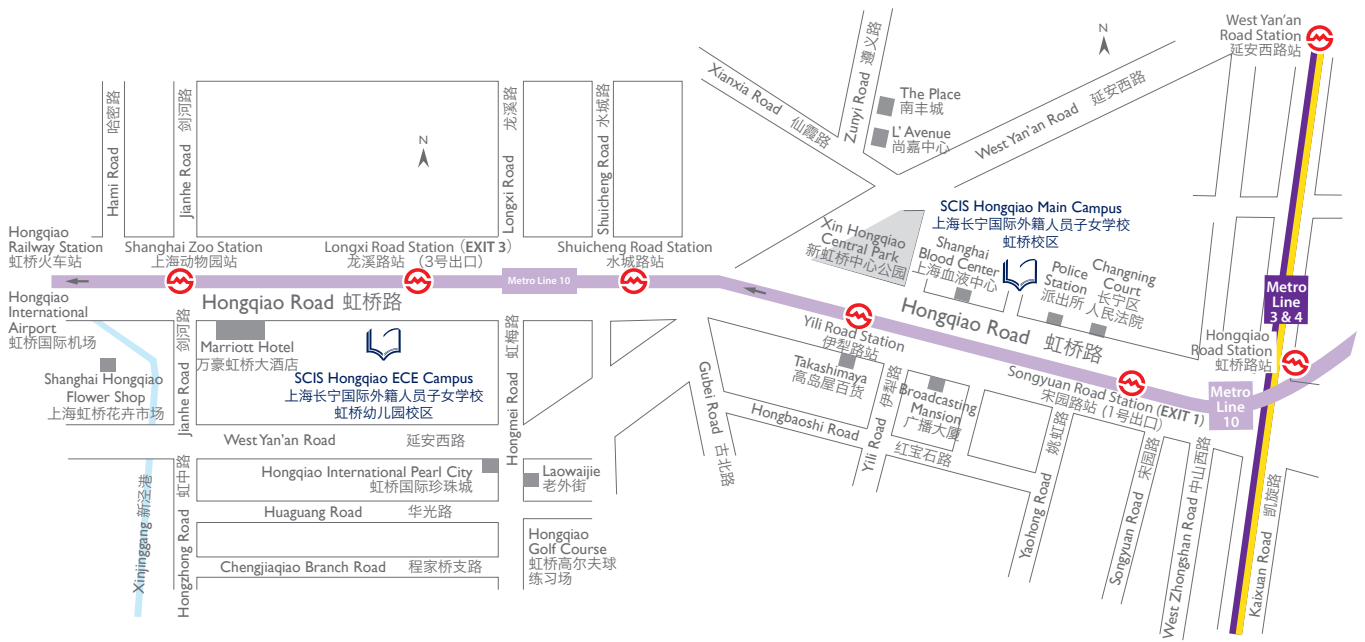

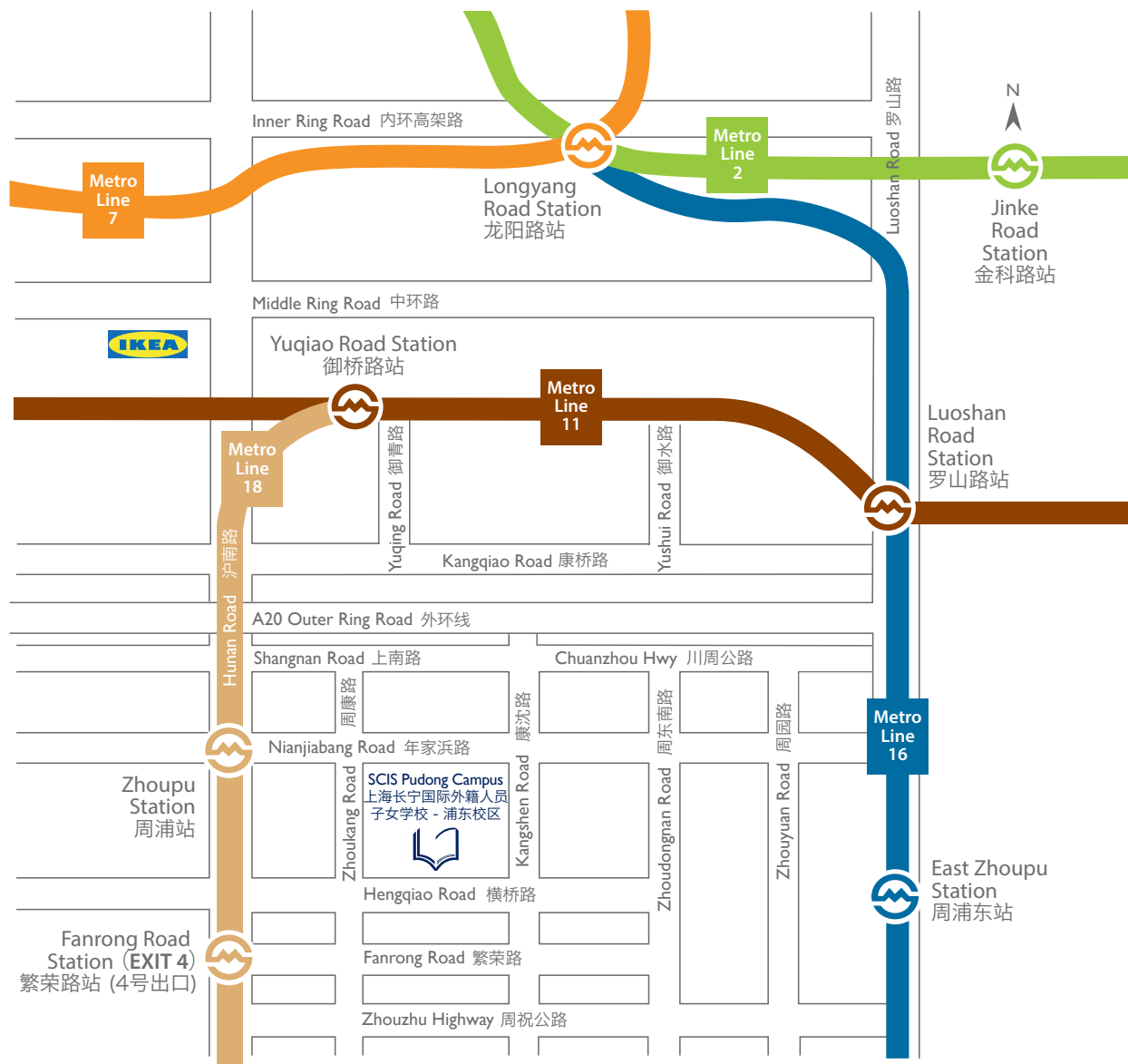
HONGQIAO CAMPUSES MAP AND POPULAR COMPOUND LIST

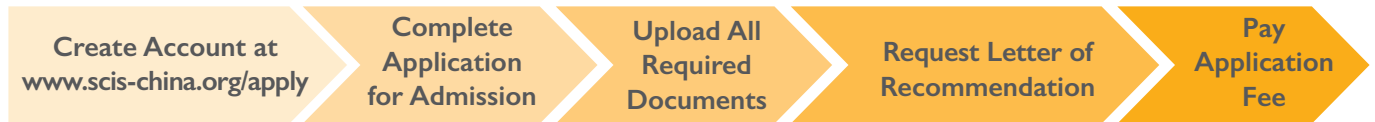

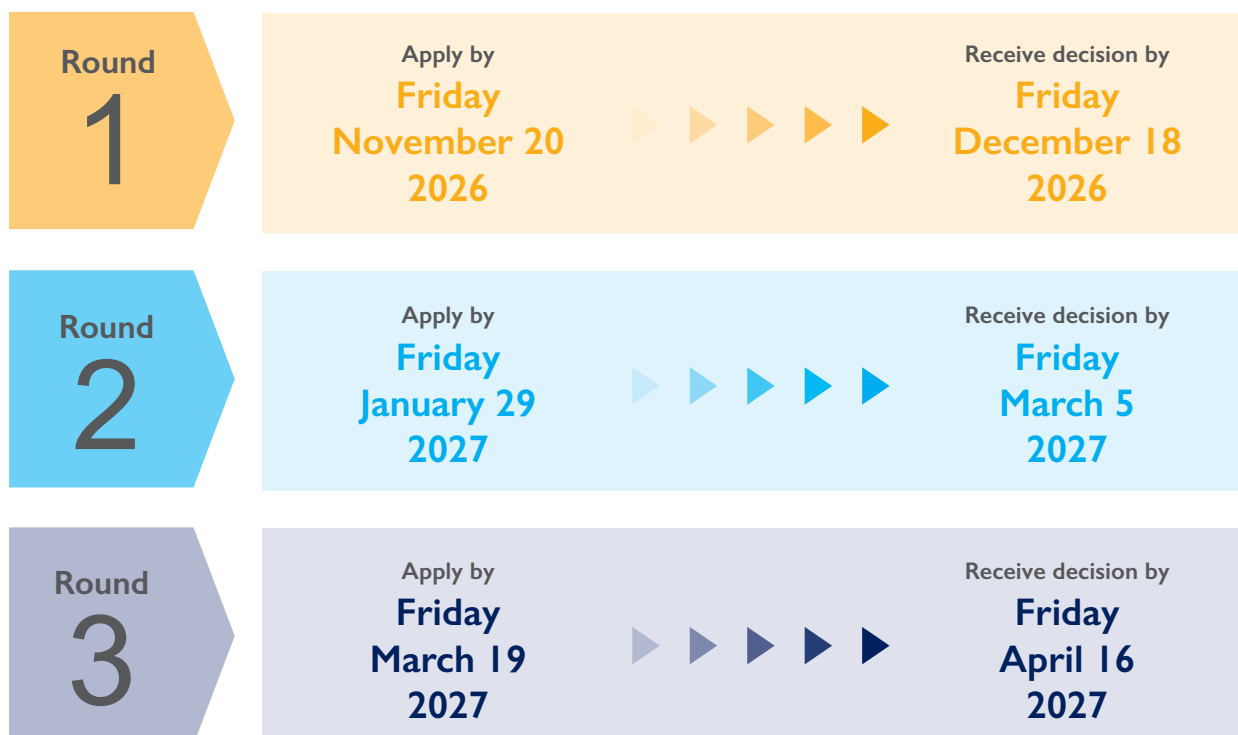

TUITION AND FEES (2026-2027)

SCIS is a non-profit educational day school governed by a self-perpetuating board of directors and overseen by the International Schools Foundation. SCIS is completely funded through student tuition and fees. When considering the tuition fee of an international school program, one thing all parents should ask themselves is, "What is included?" At SCIS, the answer is short and simple, "Everything. Our program is all-inclusive."

What is included in the SCIS program:

- All general costs associated with classes, books, library, and technology
- School lunch when on-campus
- Door-to-door bus transportation
- One set of the daily school uniform and PE uniform
- School-sponsored after-school activities
- All compulsory travel, including China Trips
- School-issued MacBook laptop for Grade 6-12
- Official invoice (fapiao) issued by the Chinese Tax Bureau

What is not included in the SCIS program:

- Extra sets of the school uniform
- Daily student snacks (or student lunch when off-campus)
- Additional one-time-only application, entrance, and supplementary admission and enrollment fees
- Student support program fees

TUITION AND FEES (2026-2027)

SEAT GUARANTEE DEPOSIT

RMB 20,000

Upon acceptance to SCIS, this deposit (which is applicable to the first semester or annual fee) will secure a seat until the June 1, 2026 tuition payment deadline. The seat guarantee deposit is due for all returning families by March 13, 2026 and is due within five working days of the offer of enrollment for new families. Once the due date has passed, a seat may be offered to other students in the wait-pool or from our new applicant pool. A refund of the seat guarantee fee will not be granted if the parent/guardian withdraws their child/ren from school, or if he/she is withdrawn due to academic, medical or behavioral concerns that inhibit their ability to remain enrolled in school.

CAPITAL FEE

FIRST YEAR - RMB 25,000 // ANNUALLY - RMB 5,000

The capital fee provides the needed funds for ongoing school facility enhancements, such as capital purchases, building maintenance, equipment and other projects aimed at school improvement. The RMB 25,000 Capital Fee is a one-time, nonrefundable fee paid upon admission for all newly enrolled students to SCIS. The RMB 5,000 Capital Fee is an annual, non-refundable fee paid upon re-enrollment for all current SCIS students returning for the next school year.

ENGLISH AS AN ADDITIONAL LANGUAGE (EAL) FEE

RMB 20,000

The one-time, non-refundable EAL fee is charged to students, grades 1–10, who require additional English language proficiency support as determined by the school. In most cases, this fee is charged pre-arrival upon enrollment, and is based on criteria supported through the application materials. In some cases, this fee is charged post-arrival after the student's English language proficiency is assessed. In all cases, students' English language proficiency will be assessed upon arrival. This fee must be paid in full upon enrollment into the EAL program.

EXAM FEES

It is the parents' responsibility to cover all external exam costs (i.e. SAT, ACT, and IB) as these exams are not part of high school graduation requirements.

APPLICATION FEE PAYMENT OPTIONS

Application Fee (RMB 3,000)

The application fee is non-refundable and payable when the student's application is completed and submitted to the school for consideration. This fee is not applicable to other school fees but is valid for up to one academic year beyond the submitted application date. No application will be reviewed until this fee is paid in full.

Methods of Payment:

- Fees may be paid by bank transfer.
- Fees may be paid by check, in RMB or US dollars (according to the daily rate of exchange), at any of our campuses.
- Fees may be paid in RMB cash at any of our campuses. We are not able to accept US dollar cash payments.
- Fees may be paid by credit/debit card (we accept all major credit cards, however transaction fees will be the responsibility of the payer).

Because wire transfers often pass through several intermediate banks before they are deposited, the process may take several days to reach the SCIS account. It is often difficult and/or impossible to determine the student or family making the payment from the bank notice of deposit. Please write your child's full name, grade, and campus in the subject line of the email.

Early Payment Discount Option

This payment option allows for up to a 5% discount on tuition fees only when annual tuition fees are paid in full for the school year by the following deadlines. Since the date of payment is determined by our bank's acknowledgement, it is advisable to allow several lead days to avoid missing the deadline. No deadline extensions will be granted.
