

Options that meet the mark.



Families may choose to purchase black uniform bottoms from outside retailers, provided they meet ISB's specifications. All self-purchased bottoms must be:

- Chino or golf style with modest fit (pants, shorts, skorts)
- Made of cotton or cotton/poly blend
- True black
- At least 5" inseam for shorts, At least 15" from waist to hem for skorts
- Free of cargo pockets, logos, stripes, or athleisure detailing

Approved items must be brought to the ISB Bookstore for inspection. Once approved, they will be embroidered with the ISB logo (100 THB fee).

As embroidery lead times may vary, we strongly encourage families to submit items as early as possible to meet the September 1 implementation.

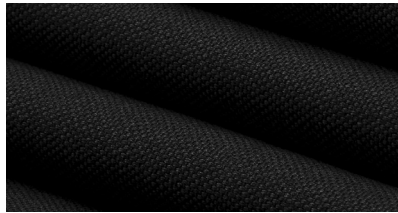

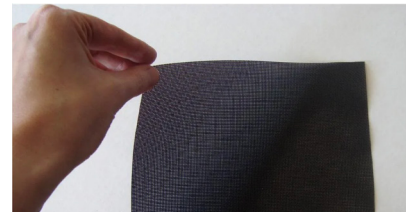

Length (Shorts/Skorts)



Shorts: Inseam must be **5 inches or longer**

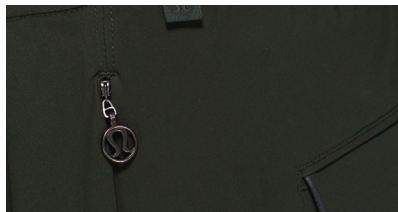
Skorts: Length from waist to hem must be **15 inches or longer**



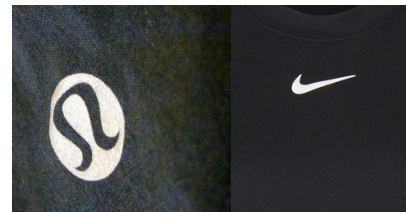
Shorts with an inseam **less than 5 inches**

Skorts with a waist-to-hem length **less than 15 inches**

BRANDING

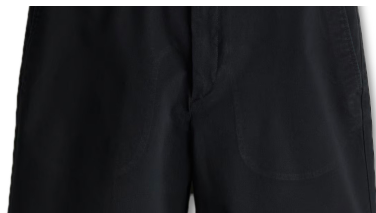


Small, same-color logos that are subtle



Large, visible, or contrasting logos and patches

STYLE

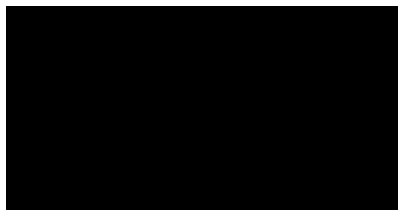


Chino or golf style, flat front, minimal design



Cargo pants, joggers, sweatpants, ripped or distressed items

Black



Faded black, charcoal, or non-uniform black tones

Important: Once an item has been approved, it must not be re-tailored or altered in any way that affects its fit or length. Students wearing altered or non-compliant items after approval will be referred to their Dean of Students for follow-up.

Step-by-Step Guide: Self-Purchased Uniform Bottoms

(For families choosing to purchase bottoms from outside ISB)

Step 1: Review ISB's Uniform Bottom Guidelines

Before purchasing, please ensure your items meet all ISB requirements:

- **Style:** Chino or golf-style shorts, pants, or skorts
- **Color:** True Black (Pantone Black C)
- **Fabric:** Cotton or cotton/poly blend
- **Length:**
 - Shorts: Minimum 5-inch inseam
 - Skorts: Minimum 15 inches (waist to hem)
- **Branding:** Any visible logos must be discreet, in matching color, and non-contrasting
- **Not Permitted:** Athletic wear, leggings, jeans, joggers, cargo pockets, contrast stitching, or oversized logos

Step 2: Purchase from Any Retailer

You may purchase from any store or online retailer.

Please keep the **receipt and tags** until the item is approved by ISB.

Step 3: Bring Items to the ISB Bookstore for Inspection

Bring your self-purchased black bottoms to the ISB Bookstore for approval. A staff member will inspect the item for compliance with ISB guidelines.

- **If approved**, the item may be worn during August **without embroidery**.
- Embroidery will be required beginning **September 1**.
- **All items will be re-checked by the Bookstore before embroidery is applied.**

Important: Once an item has been approved, it must not be re-tailored or altered in any way that affects its fit or length. Students wearing altered or non-compliant items after approval will be referred to their **Dean of Students** for follow-up.



Step-by-Step Guide:

Self-Purchased Uniform Bottoms

(For families choosing to purchase bottoms from outside ISB)

Step 4: Embroidery of the ISB Logo

Once the item is re-approved for embroidery:

- It will be submitted for official ISB logo embroidery at the Bookstore
- **Cost:** 100 THB per item
- Embroidery timing will depend on volume and availability
- Families will be notified once embroidery is complete

Step 5: What to Wear While Waiting

Students may wear the following while their garment is being embroidered:

- **Approved self-purchased black bottoms are permitted in August without embroidery.**
- **Elementary & Middle School: PE shorts or previously approved black ISB bottoms**
- **High School:**
 - PE shorts are not permitted as daily uniform
 - Students may wear previously issued black ISB shorts with the ISB logo and approved length

Step 6: Pick Up and Wear

Once embroidery is complete, you will be notified.

After pickup, your item may be worn as part of the official ISB school uniform.

Sales & Supply Update

Due to limited inventory, sales of ISB uniform bottoms will prioritize **new families** and **students transitioning divisions**.

Returning families are kindly asked to purchase **only if necessary**; all other requests will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.

If a student urgently needs to purchase a uniform item, they may approach their **Dean of Students** for support and approval. For further assistance, please contact the ISB Bookstore directly.
