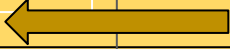

Counseling Department - Schedule Corrections



Student schedules will be accessible in the Home Access Center (HAC) on Wednesday, August 19. Instructions for accessing the HAC are located on the [District Website](#) - Parents - Grades

Students who meet the criteria below may request a schedule change via this [Google link](#). In accordance with the Bentonville Schools High School Course Catalog (page 26), schedule corrections are permissible only if it meets one of the following criteria:

- **A student previously completed the class**
- **A student is missing a course needed for graduation requirements**
- **A course that requires a try-out or audition and needs to be added**
- **A prerequisite of the course is not met**
- **9th-11th graders do not have a full schedule of 7 classes per semester**
- **12th graders (only) wish to request a partial day schedule**

Counseling Department - Schedule Corrections



- Graduation-required classes are the first priority in scheduling, but due to the many moving pieces it takes to create a master schedule, students are never guaranteed their first choice of classes.
- You will have until the end of the 5th day of classes to request a change. Counselors will work via the submitted Google form in the order the requests are received and will not be able to respond to phone calls or emails regarding schedules. We appreciate your patience, as this is a very lengthy process and we are doing our best to accommodate every student.
- Students are expected to attend each class for which they are scheduled, even if they are pending a possible schedule change.
- Students are not to wait in the counseling center, hallways, or leave campus while waiting for a change. Please allow until the end of the 2nd week of school for a change request to be reviewed and/or accommodated.



Parent Check In/Out Procedures

- Parents check ins/outs will be limited.
- Parents should use the intercom system installed on the outside of the North building entrance to check a student in or out of the building. To connect with a staff member, for privacy parents can call the following number 696-3532. This number will be posted beside the intercom system.
- Parents will not have access to the Main Office.
- Parents/Guardians must provide identification through the intercom system.
- There will be a staff member assigned to the phone for this service.



My Payments Plus

All student payments for extracurricular activities and fines are made through MyPaymentsPlus. To set up a MyPaymentsPlus account click [Here](#).

All students will need a MyPaymentsPlus Account

STEPS:

1. Visit www.mypaymentsplus.com
2. Select your state and school district
3. Enter your first and last name along with your email address
4. Create a password with at least 7 characters (include at least one number)
5. Select the option that represents you best: parent/guardian/staff member/student
6. Add your student(s) to the account (must have student ID number)
7. Click “done”



Nurse Information-Medication at School

Medications students need on a daily basis or as needed:

- A Doctor's note is required for over-the-counter medications and prescription medications to be dispensed from the Nurse's Office.
- Parents must bring the medication in its original container, clearly labeled with the doctor's note stipulating how to dispense the medication.
- Parent's must schedule an appointment with the Nurse's Office to turn in medication.

Hallway Procedures - North Building

- Hallways will be two directions.
- Always travel on the right hand side.
- Stairwells in the north will be two directional. Always travel on the right hand side.

Directional signage will be in place. Provided by the district.



Hallway Procedures - South Building

- Two main staircases in the South Commons - will be one-directional. Students will only go up these staircases to the second floor.
- The enclosed staircases will be one-directional. Students will only go down these staircases to the first floor.

Directional signage will be in place. Provided by the district.



Lunchroom Procedures

- Lunchroom tables will be marked with Tiger heads to show students where to sit.
- Round tables will have 4 students per table and rectangle tables will have 6 students per table.
- There will be three tables marked for students with food allergies.
- Students will be instructed to stay seated until the bell rings.
- Duty teachers will rotate around the lunchroom to insure students are staying at designated areas.
- Students will also eat in the classroom.
- Teachers will receive a duty schedule with assigned days.
- Teachers with zero hour students will be assigned 3rd lunch.

- Every BHS PTO membership includes the opportunity for your Senior Student to apply for a PTO Scholarship (*in 2019-2020 PTO awarded seven \$500 scholarships to PTO Members' Senior Students*).
- Membership incentives dependent upon donor level include yearbook mentions and more.
