

The Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) is a federal program to provide all children significant opportunity to receive a fair, equitable, and high-quality education, and to close educational achievement gaps. A requirement of ESSA is that each school shall jointly develop with and distribute to parents and family members a written plan that describes how the school will meet legislative requirements.

OUR PLAN TO MEET ESSA REQUIREMENTS

- Convene an annual meeting at a convenient time, to inform parents of the school's participation in and requirements of Title I and the parents' rights to be involved.
- Offer a flexible number of meetings (morning, evening, etc.) so that as many parents as possible are able to attend.
- Involve parents in an organized, ongoing, and timely way, in the planning, review, and improvement of Title I programs, including the planning, review, and improvement of the school parent and family engagement plan and the joint development of the schoolwide program.

Provide parents:

- If requested by parents, opportunities for regular meetings to formulate suggestions and to participate, as appropriate, in decisions relating to the education of their children, and respond to any such suggestions as soon as practicably possible.

TITLE I MEETINGS

- 1. Hold an Annual Meeting to inform parents that the school participates in the Title I program, explain the program's requirements, and outline parents' rights to be involved.**
- 2. Offer flexible parent and family engagement meetings, such as in the morning or evening, so that as many parents as possible are able to attend.**
- 3. Involve parents in the development, review, and improvement of the school's Parent and Family Engagement Plan, Compact, and Title I Program.**
