Project 1: Artist & Style Study

In this project, you will explore the world of fine arts by analyzing artists and their work. You will examine different artistic styles, techniques, and themes to better understand how artists communicate ideas and express creativity. Using your research, you will identify patterns and trends across artists and movements.

Step 1: Research Artist or Artworks

Analyze **5–8 artists or individual works of art** (historical or contemporary).

Record the following for each:

- Artist name and time period
- Medium (painting, sculpture, digital, mixed media, etc.)
- Style or movement (impressionism, abstract, realism, etc.)
- Themes or subject matter
- Techniques used (brushwork, color use, texture, composition, etc.)

Step 2: Organize Your Data

- Create a comparison chart or table (digital or hand-created)
- Clearly display all artists/artworks and their details
- Group or sort in a meaningful way (by style, theme, or medium)

Step 3: Analyze Trends & Themes

Identify patterns such as:

- Common themes or messages
- Similar techniques across artists
- Differences between styles or time periods
- How artists use elements of art (color, line, texture, etc.)

Answer:

- What trends do you notice across the artists or works?
- What techniques seem most effective?
- How do artists communicate meaning or emotion?

Step 4: Make Observations & Insights

Based on your findings, explain:

- What makes artwork impactful or meaningful?
- What approaches or techniques stand out most?

Provide 2–3 specific insights supported by your research.

Final Deliverables (2 Completed Projects)

1) Comparison Chart (Required)

A clear chart or table showing your 5–8 artists/artworks and their details

2) Written Analysis (Required)

Choose one format:

- 1–2 page written summary
- OR
- 10–12 slide presentation

Your analysis must include:

- Overview of artists or works studied
- Key trends and themes
- Explanation of techniques and styles
- Your insights about what makes art effective

Project 1: Artist & Style Study

In this project, you will apply what you've learned by creating your own original artwork. You will develop a small series of pieces inspired by the styles, themes, or techniques you studied. You will also reflect on your creative choices through an artist statement.

Step 1: Plan Your Artwork Series

Decide:

- Theme or message of your series
- Medium (drawing, painting, digital, mixed media, etc.)
- Style or techniques inspired by your research

Step 2: Create Your Artwork

Create **2–4 original pieces**.

Your work should:

- Reflect a clear theme or concept
- Show intentional use of techniques
- Demonstrate effort and creativity

Step 3: Reflect on Your Work

Consider:

- What inspired your pieces
- What techniques you used and why
- How your work connects to the artists or styles you studied

Step 4: Write Your Artist Statement

Write a 1-page artist statement that explains:

- Your theme or message
- Your artistic choices (medium, style, techniques)
- Influences from your research
- What you want viewers to understand or feel

Final Deliverables

1. Artwork (Required)

- 2–4 original pieces forming a cohesive series

2. Artist Statement (Required)

- A 1-page written explanation of your work and creative process

3) Extension Activities

- Create a digital portfolio of your work
