1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

During the 2025–26 school year, the Oroville Union High School District (OUHSD) continued to utilize Arts and Music in Schools (Prop 28) funding to expand and strengthen arts education opportunities for students across the district. Building upon the programs established in prior years, OUHSD maintained additional course sections in Ceramics and Theater at Las Plumas High School, Oroville High School, and Prospect High School, providing increased access to visual and performing arts instruction. To further enhance career-connected learning opportunities, the district continued development of its Arts, Media, and Entertainment (AME) pathway and provided staffing support to expand student participation and engagement in arts-related coursework. Prop 28 funding also supported paraeducator assistance within Visual and Performing Arts (VAPA) classrooms, allowing for increased instructional support and improved learning experiences for students. In addition, funds were used to purchase instructional materials, equipment, and supplies necessary to sustain and enhance VAPA programs. These investments helped ensure students had access to high-quality resources that support creativity, artistic expression, and hands-on learning across multiple disciplines.
