**Description:**

Participants will revise Grade 6 Humanities curriculum

- Create a pacing guide and establish pacing recommendations and performance tasks
- Embed projects, plans and literacy strategies that align to the Science of Reading best instructional practices for secondary education
- Identify opportunities for explicit vocabulary instruction, including academic and content-specific terminology.
- Develop text-based discussion and writing protocols that strengthen comprehension and knowledge building.
- Integrate structured reading routines that promote fluency, background knowledge development, and evidence-based reasoning.
