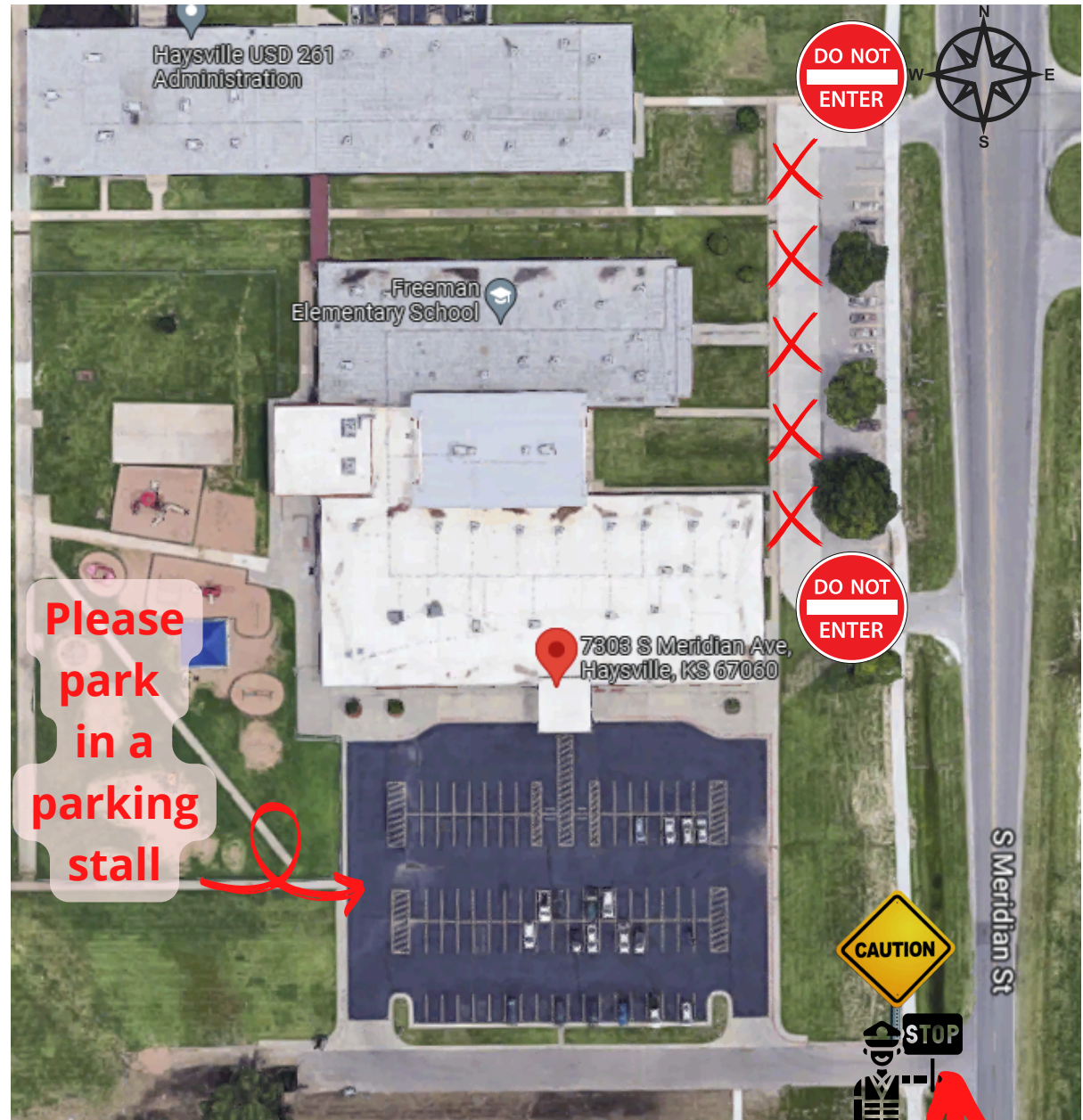

the school.**

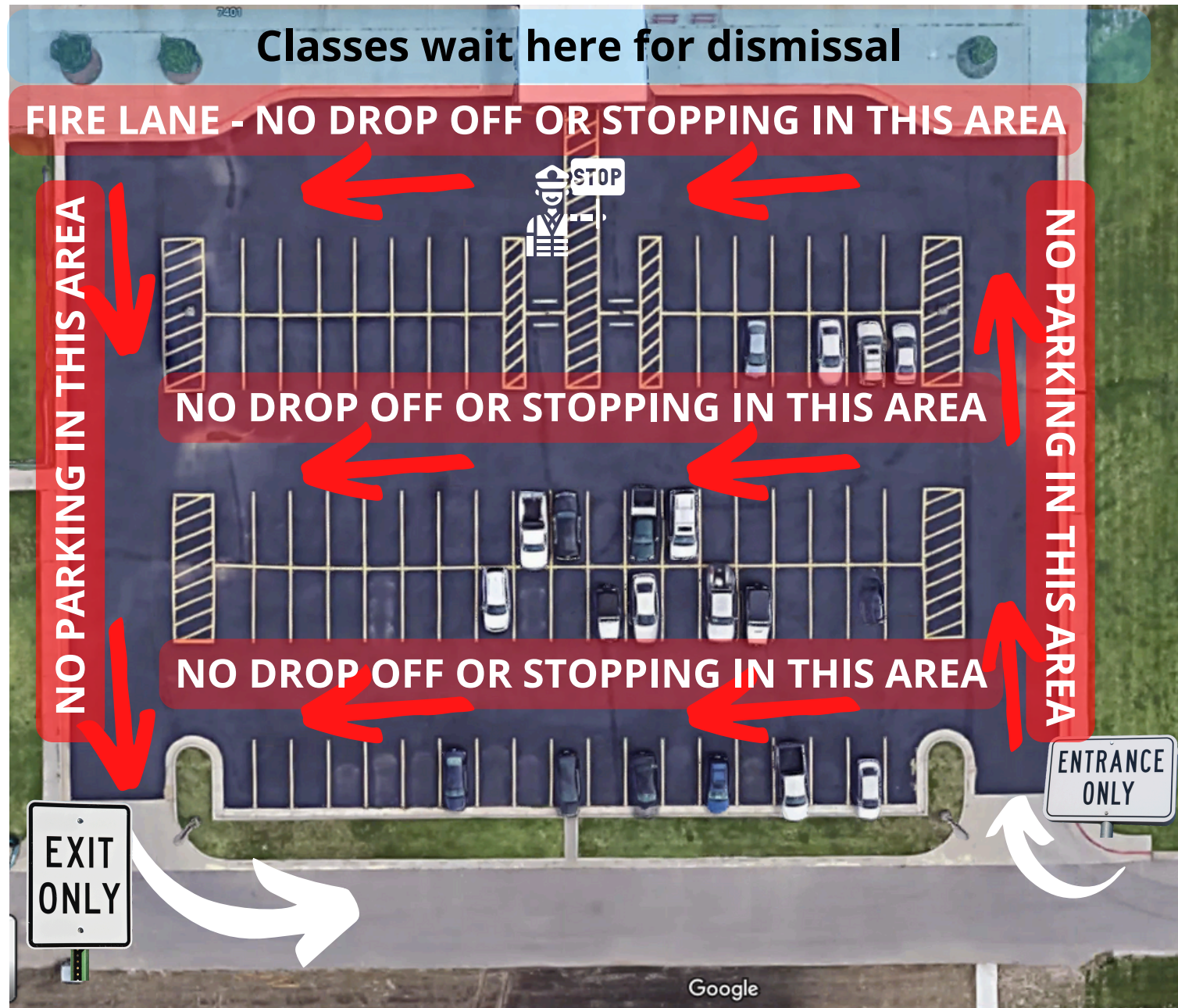


Two way driveway

DROP-OFF & PICK-UP PROCEDURES

Parents must park in a stall for both Drop-off and Pick-up. Then walk up to your student's grade level cone.

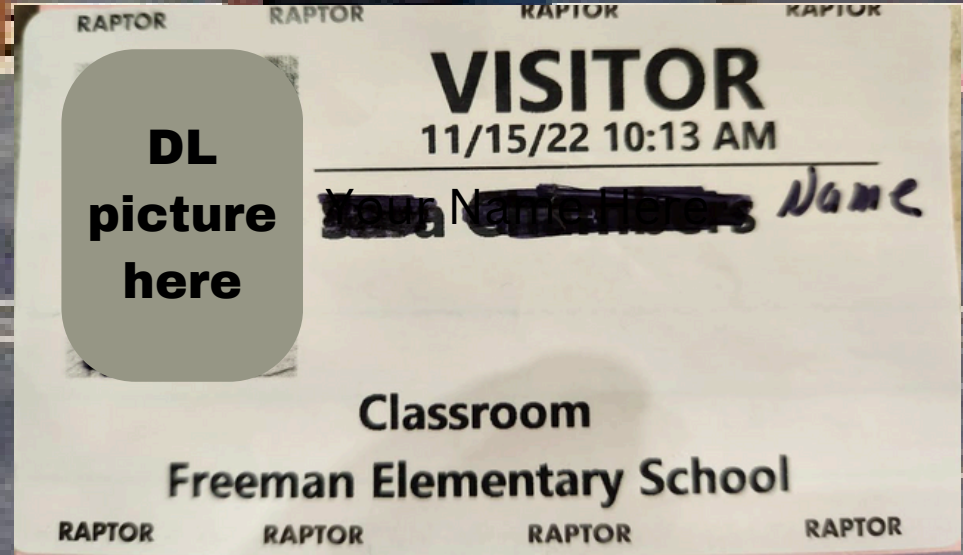
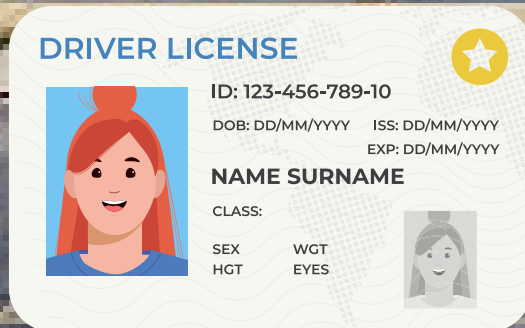
Do not park in the fire lane. You can pull into a parking stall closest to the fire lane, but not the fire lane itself. There will be a staff member to stop cars so that kids can cross safely.



Please follow these guidelines so that the safety of our students, staff, and family picking up students can be assured.

Reminder:

Anyone entering the building must have their driver's license to get a visitor pass before going past the office. This is a district-wide policy, there are no exceptions to this rule.
