Work Permits

Students who are between the ages of 14-17 and have obtained after school jobs will need a work permit signed by the school. Work permits are available in the AHS main office. Students should fill out the top portion of the permit, then have their employer fill out the bottom part. They may also need a physical from their physician. After these parts are completed, they can return the form to AHS and we will issue the work permit. In the summer, work permits may take longer to process and we encourage students to plan ahead. The work permit and instructions may be printed at home by scanning the QR code below.

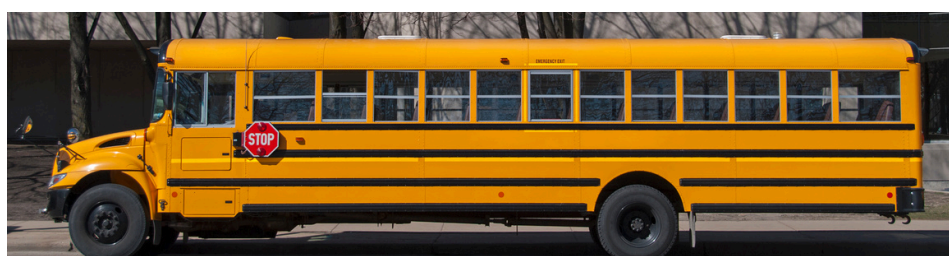

Vaccines for Seniors

All students who will be entering 12th grade are required to have Meningitis vaccine given on or after the age of 16 years of age. Please make sure your student is up to date and the school has a record of their vaccination. Ohio's immunization requirements can be found at the QR code to the right.



Final Forms

In order to be cleared for athletics and to pick up schedules in August, all parents and students will need to go through Final Forms. We encourage you not to wait until late July or August to complete your Final Forms updates. Your student will also have a part to complete (sent to them in an email) once you are done with the parent portion. Students who attend the career center must update their Final Forms account for both AHS and fill out the career center's forms. This ensures that families do not miss important communications from Ashland High School about events throughout the year.

We know back to school clothes shopping happens all summer long. Please keep our dress code in mind as you shop.

The effectiveness of the minimum standard of dress can only be achieved through joint cooperation from students, faculty, and parents. Dress and personal appearance shall be clean and appropriate for the school environment. Any clothing or accessories that are inappropriate, disruptive, or dangerous to the health and safety of students and other members of the school community are not permitted. An instructor or administrator has the discretion to reasonably alter the stated dress code standards to meet the needs of students participating in extracurricular activities, lab situations, or internship/career related programs. This policy can be enforced for all students in attendance at any school sponsored event. Building administrators will be the final arbiters of appropriate student dress and grooming and reserve the right to address anything that is dangerous or disruptive but not directly mentioned here.

The following dress code standards have been established with the input of certified staff, administration, parents, and students.

Students must wear

- Clothing that is opaque (not transparent) and covers the student's back, chest, torso, buttocks, and private areas.
- **A top and bottom that meet when the student is standing.**
- Shoes with treads.

Students may wear

- Hats or headgear that does not obscure their identity in person or on camera. (Teachers may set headwear expectations that are appropriate for their individual classrooms.)

Students may not wear

- Clothing and tattoos that promote or illustrate tobacco, alcohol, drugs, violence, or sex or depict immoral subjects, indecent connotations, or racist themes.
- Shoes with built-in wheels or that have no tread.
- Hoods that cover the head and ears.
- Clothing that is excessively tight or baggy.
- Clothing that exposes undergarments (excluding bra straps).
- Clothing that exposes the midriff, sides of the chest or torso under the armpit.
- Clothing or accessories that would cause a safety concern (such as chains, jewelry with spikes, or gloves with metal or hard surfaces).
- Flags that were not designed to be part of an article of clothing. (Flag emblems or pictures on clothing are permitted.)
