SUMMER ASSIGNMENTS

Summer assignments for all grade levels and AP courses will be posted on our website on May 29, 2026. These assignments are mandatory and must be submitted during the first week of school to the student's assigned teacher.

Supply lists for the Preschool & Lower School (Grades PK-5) will be available on our website by April 2nd. Middle and Upper School students will not receive supply lists in advance; instead, each student will receive a syllabus from their assigned classes during the first week of school, which will include all required supplies. (All Middle and Upper School students are required to have headphones and a stylus pen)



IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- **i-Pad (Middle & Upper school)**

- Mater Bay Middle and Upper School is a mandatory i-Pad school. All students are required to have a school issued i-Pad to access their educational resources and curriculum.
- A mandatory technology fee must be paid prior to iPad distribution.
 - This fee supports classroom technologies, academic software, IT and network security, device troubleshooting and coverage for accidental damage.
 - Fee does not cover tampered or broken screen protectors and cases.
