STIPULATION OF SETTLEMENT

BOARD RESOLUTION APPROVING SETTLEMENT OF PERB CHARGE

WHEREAS, on or about March 30, 2026, the HCTA filed a Charge with PERB, which was assigned case # U-40303, alleging that the District violated the "Taylor Law" (N.Y. Civil Service Law § 209-a.1(a) and (c), et seq.); and

WHEREAS, on or about May 4, 2026, the District filed its Answer to the Charge in case # U-40303, and thereby denied any wrongdoing generally, and specifically denied violating N.Y. Civil Service Law § 209-a.1(a) and § 209-a.1(c); and

WHEREAS, on or about May 15, 2026, the presiding Judge at PERB, the Hon. Albina Khaimova, ALJ, held a pre-hearing conference at which the Superintendent of Schools, through Labor Counsel negotiated a resolution of the PERB charge; and

NOW THEREFORE, it is **RESOLVED**, that the District agrees to settle the PERB charge filed by the HCTA pursuant to the terms of the Stipulation of Settlement between the HCTA and the District; and it is further **RESOLVED**, that the Board President is authorized to execute the Stipulation of Settlement on behalf of the District.
