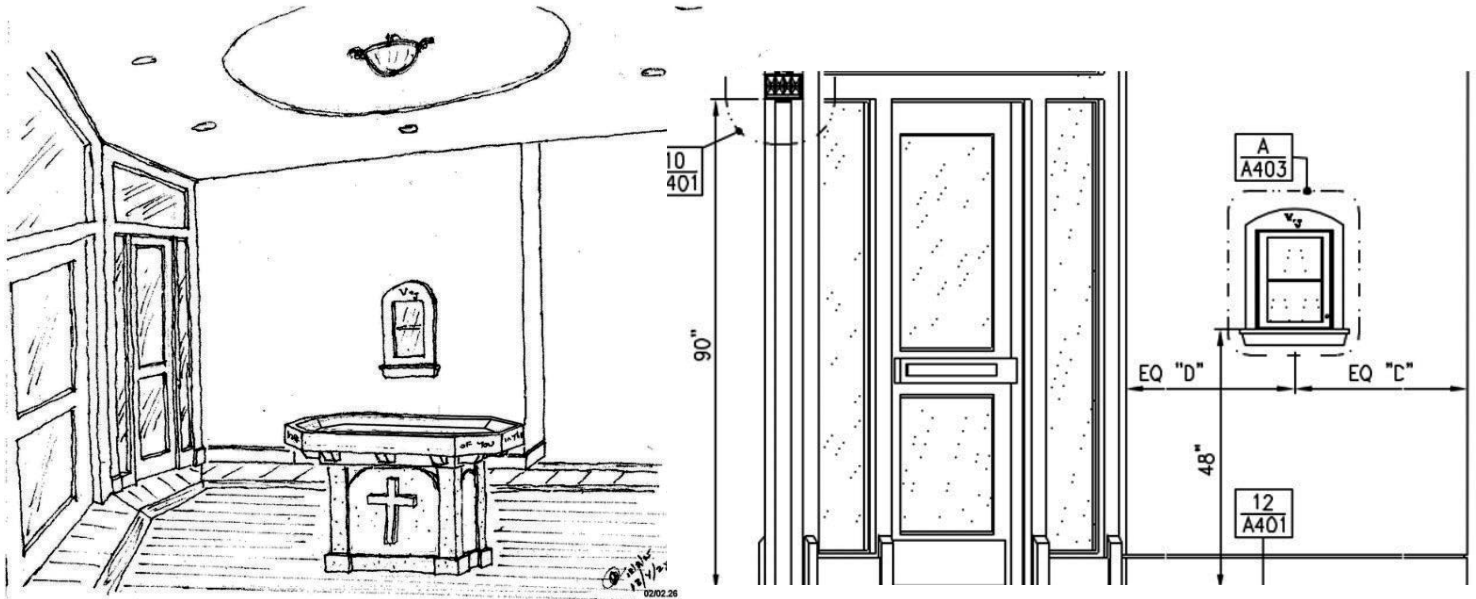

UNDER CONSTRUCTION



An Ambry is a small, secure cabinet or recessed niche found in a Catholic Church that is used to store the sacred oils used in the sacraments. These oils are blessed by the Bishop during the Chrism Mass in Holy Week and include the Oil of Catechumens, the Oil of the Sick, and the Sacred Chrism.

The Ambry is important because it safeguards these holy oils, which play a vital role in the sacramental life of the Church. The oils are used in Baptism, Confirmation, Anointing of the Sick, and Holy Orders, symbolizing healing, strengthening, consecration, and the presence of the Holy Spirit. Because these oils are considered sacred, the Ambry is often placed in a visible and dignified location near the Sacristy or Baptismal Font. The Ambry serves as a visible reminder of the Church's sacramental mission and the grace God imparts through the sacraments.

The Ambry will have the V+J engraved in a central location as a reference to our parish connection to the Oblates of St. Francis de Sales and as a constant reminder of our mission to Live Jesus in our everyday lives through charity, humility, gentleness, prayer, and service to others.

UPDATE: AEDs at OLGC

Due to renovations to the Church outlined in the Cornerstone Project, the AED in the Church Narthex has been moved to DeSales Hall. Another AED is now installed outside the Chapel, close to the doors nearest to the Administration Building. DeSales Hall is closed at times, and thus that AED is not accessible at all times. The Chapel's addition of a new AED ensures that lifesaving equipment is always available.

Additional AED units are located in the following OLGC areas:

- * DeSales Hall lower level in the preschool, Room E
- * Administration Building by the water fountain
- * St. Joseph Center (in the stairwell going up to the second floor)
- * School, outside the Health Clinic (close to the main entrance)
- * School, outside the gym
- * School, 2nd floor, by the elevator close to the resource and math rooms

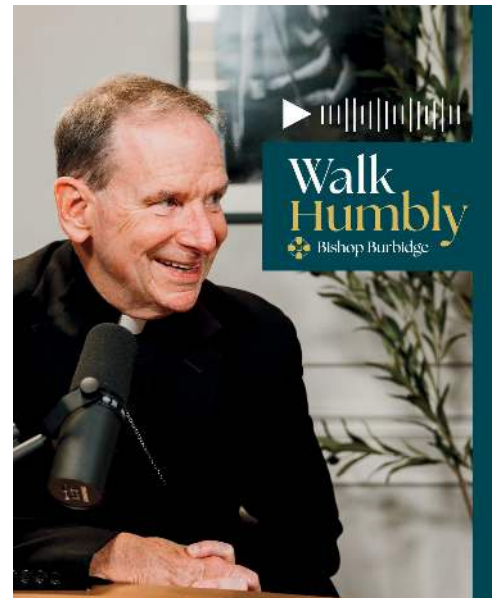

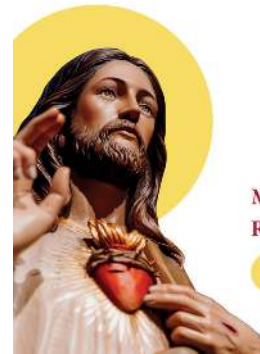

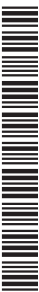
