**HOW WILL WE IMPROVE?**

**Schoolwide Strategies:**

- Faculty professional development meetings, department meetings and Teacher Collaborations. In Teacher Collaborations meetings will review and analyze data, common planning and assessments, sharing of strategies and curriculum alignment.
- Parental engagement activities and transition activities in support of the SIP programs and goals. Activities will provide families with insight into the curriculum and assessments used to guide student achievement.
- Implementing the Louisiana State Standards using Tier I Curricula, teachers will utilize targeted strategies to drive standards based instruction and assessments. Materials, resources, and updated technology will be available to teachers and students as determined for program implementation.

**SCHOOLWIDE PLAN GOAL 3 for all Non-Proficient Subgroups**

**Schoolwide Goal:** By the end of the 2025-2026 school year, Richwood High School will increase its school performance score from 25.3/F to 49.1/B based on the new Grow, Achieve, and Thrive accountability system.

**Schoolwide Strategies:** The school will use district staff and supports to assist teachers and administrators with strategies to assist identified subgroups to master the state standards.
