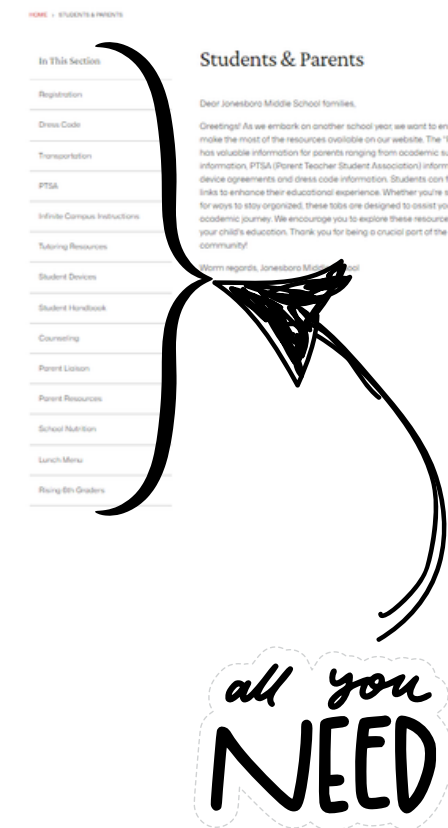
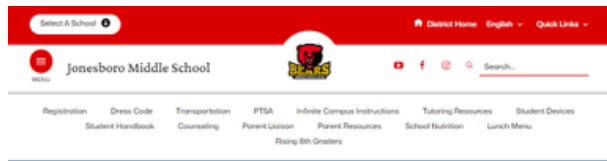

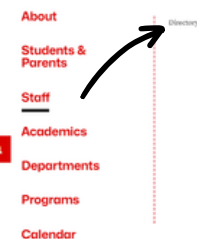
Parent Communication

If you have a school-related issue (grades, classroom experience, assignments, etc.) concerning your child:

Step 1 - Contact your child's teacher. Teachers are expected to respond within a reasonable timeframe (24-48 hours). While teachers will make every effort to respond to you within this timeframe, contact the teacher again if you do not receive an email or phone call within 24-48 hours. If you still do not receive a return email or call after the second attempt, proceed to the next step.

Step 2 - If the issue has not been resolved at the teacher level, contact your child's school assistant principal or principal. [The expectation is that all issues are resolved at the school level.]

Step 3 - However, if the issue has not been resolved at the school level [including teacher, assistant principal, or principal]: a. Contact the area superintendent b. In very rare cases, contact the school district's chief of school.
