Superintendent's Comments - Dr. Alan S. Futrick

The district recently celebrated teacher appreciation week and he can't say enough of the work that the district teachers do day in and day out in the classroom, motivating the kids, creating a great environment; but really helping to make a difference. He is very appreciative of their work and just wanted to take that time to recognize them. Dr. Futrick spoke about Mr. Dan Fair is retiring this year and appreciates everything he has done for the district, thanking him and all of the teachers for their contributions to the kids and really impacting so many of them. Mrs. Mengle spoke about the proposed final budget, before voting she would like to thank Mr. Mathias and Dr. Futrick and the board for all working together to get to where the district is with the budget. She talked about when they first started working on the budget a few months ago, they were not sure they would be able to be under the index; it took teamwork and compromise. Mrs. Mengle advised it makes her happy that they can now include the construction of the CTC which they were not sure they would even be able to do; they all worked together and when board members had suggestions, they were heard. She talked about some things that were not possible, but they made it work and did this without affecting the education of the students. Mrs. Mengle talked about starting to work on the budget in September for next school year, although no promises can be made due to an increase out of the district's control, the goal next year will be to have an even lesser of a tax increase with a hope of no increase. She thanked again for all of the hard work and working together as a team to get this budget done and wanted to challenge the administration to sharpen their pencils and come back to the board next month with a plan for even a lower tax increase that they can vote on next month.
