- Mr. Stenftenagel requesting approval of the SafeEVAC agreement for the JHS classroom addition (2025 Bond)

This is to amendment the existing safety contract and add the safety system hardware, installation, and monitoring services for the new north classroom addition at the Jasper High School. The cost is \$68,500

A motion by Dr. Englert, second by Sara Schmidt to approve amending the SafeEvac agreement in the amount of \$68,500 was unanimously approved by the Board.

Curriculum Update—Tina Fawks

- Requesting approval for the 2026-2027 curricular materials and fees

The 26-27 curricular materials and student fees were included in the board packet for review ahead of the meeting.

A motion by Arlet Jackle, second by Dr. Englert to approve 26-27 curricular materials and fees, was unanimously approved by the Board.

- Requesting approval for Purdue Extension to host The Food Factory summer garden program at JES

This would be an eight-week program that would meet once per week for 60-90 minutes and provide hands-on nutrition education, STEM activities, tastes testing, and a free farmers market featuring produce from the JES garden. This program is aligned with the corporation's summer lunch program, allowing families to receive free meals and participate in garden-based enrichment activities.

A motion by Arlet Jackle, second by Dr. Englert to approve The Food Factory summer garden program at JES, was unanimously approved by the Board.

Student Support Services and Transportation Update—Ryan Erny

- Requesting approval to continue our agreement with Sodexo as the Food Service Management Company for 2026-2027 (School Lunch Fund)

There was a guaranteed savings of \$125,000 from last year that is expected to be met. The new contract would be \$100,000 and that is due to Sodexo assuming more personnel-related costs. Questions have been asked about the survey that went out mid-year and what those results were. Overall, the results were very well received, with notes of bringing back more scratch-cooked meals

A motion by Dr. Englert, second by Sara Schmidt to approve continuing with Sodexo for 26-27 school year, was unanimously approved by the Board

- Requesting approval for increasing 2026-2027 student/adult lunch meal pricing

The pricing for student/adult lunch meals would be increased for \$.25. We will not be offering the free universal breakfast for 26-27 school year. Please see attachment.

A motion by Arlet Jackle, second by Sara Schmidt to approve student/adult lunch price for the 26-27 school year, was unanimously approved by the Board

Other Business:

Dr. Lorey presented the bylaw changes reflecting the current statutes in Indiana and federal law. She is not asking for approval tonight. She is asking the board to review those changes for consideration of approval at the June board meeting.

A motion by Dr. Englert, second by Arlet Jackle to approve the Budget 27', was unanimously approved by the Board.

AMENDMENT

GREATER JASPER CONSOLIDATED SCHOOLS

AND

SODEXO MANAGEMENT, INC.

**THIS AMENDMENT, dated May 7, 2026 is between GREATER JASPER
CONSOLIDATED SCHOOLS ("SFA") and SODEXO MANAGEMENT, INC. ("FSMC").**

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, SFA and FSMC entered into a certain Request for Proposal released on January 31, 2023, with an effective date of July 1, 2023 ("Effective Date"), supplemented with an Addendum dated April 5, 2023 and May 30, 2025, as amended (collectively the "Agreement"), whereby Sodexo manages and operates Client's Food Service operation at SFA's premises as set forth in the Request for Proposal; and

WHEREAS, the parties now desire to further amend the aforesaid Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises herein contained and for other good and valuable consideration, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. As set forth in Paragraph G (Renewal Assumptions) on page 12 of the Agreement, financial terms of the Agreement are based upon existing conditions and the following assumptions. If there is a material change in conditions, including, without limitations, changes to the following assumptions, this contract (1) may be terminated at the end of the current term or (2) continue under the same terms as written, whichever is mutually agreed upon. The Guarantee Language is deleted in its entirety and the following substituted therefore:

"Guarantee Language

FSMC guarantees that SFA shall have a Surplus for the 2026-2027 academic year of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00). If the actual Surplus for the food service program falls short of the aforementioned amount, FSMC shall pay the difference to SFA up to an amount not to exceed the actual Administrative Fee. Current and prior year FSMC reimbursed amounts may be recovered by FSMC from current food service Surplus but only pursuant to contractual terms for the subsequent contract year."

2. The SFA and FSMC agree to adhere to the terms set forth in the attached Farm To School Addendum.

3. This Amendment is effective as of July 1, 2026 and thereafter, unless amended. All other terms and conditions contained in the Agreement shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect, except by necessary implication.

First Amendment to the SafeEVAC Design and Installation Agreement

THIS AMENDMENT (the “**Amendment**”) to the SafeEVAC Design and Installation Agreement effective June 23rd, 2025 (the “**Agreement**”) dated May 7th, 2026 is entered into by and between Owner and SafeEVAC.

WHEREAS, the parties have entered into the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement was made pursuant to Project Title: Design and Installation of SafeEVAC system at Jasper High School at 1600 St. Charles Street, Jasper, IN 47546 (“**Site**”); and

WHEREAS, Owner has accepted SafeEVAC’s proposal to expand the SafeEVAC System into the north side addition of the Site.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the parties hereby agree:

ARTICLE 1 DEFINITIONS

1.1 Capitalized terms used and not defined in this Amendment have the respective meanings assigned to them in the Agreement.

ARTICLE 2 PROCESS REQUIREMENTS

2.1 **Rough Order of Magnitude**. Owner has previously provided building plans and layout to SafeEVAC, and SafeEVAC has developed and delivered a Rough Order of Magnitude of the approximate estimated cost of \$68,500.00 and equipment needed for the SafeEVAC System addition to the Site (“**ROM**”).

2.2 **Approval of Project Schedule**. Upon execution of this Agreement, SafeEVAC, Owner, and SafeEVAC Alliance Partner shall meet to finalize the Project Schedule as determined and approved by Owner, which shall then be attached hereto as Schedule 2.2 (“**Project Schedule**”). Owner shall deliver any and all additional documents required for the initial design of the evacuation plans within thirty (30) days of such meeting.

2.3 **Development of Final Floor Plans**. After review of the final Project Schedule, SafeEVAC and SafeEVAC Alliance Partner, shall develop the Final Floor Plans (as defined below) in accordance with the final Project Schedule:

a. SafeEVAC shall create and deliver the initial floor plans with location of devices (“**Initial Floor Plans**”) for review by OWNER.

b. SafeEVAC, Owner, and SafeEVAC Alliance Partner shall meet in accordance with the final Project Schedule to discuss and provide feedback on the Initial Floor Plans;

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties, by their duly authorized and empowered officers, execute this First Amendment to the SafeEVAC Design and Installation Agreement as of the Effective Date.

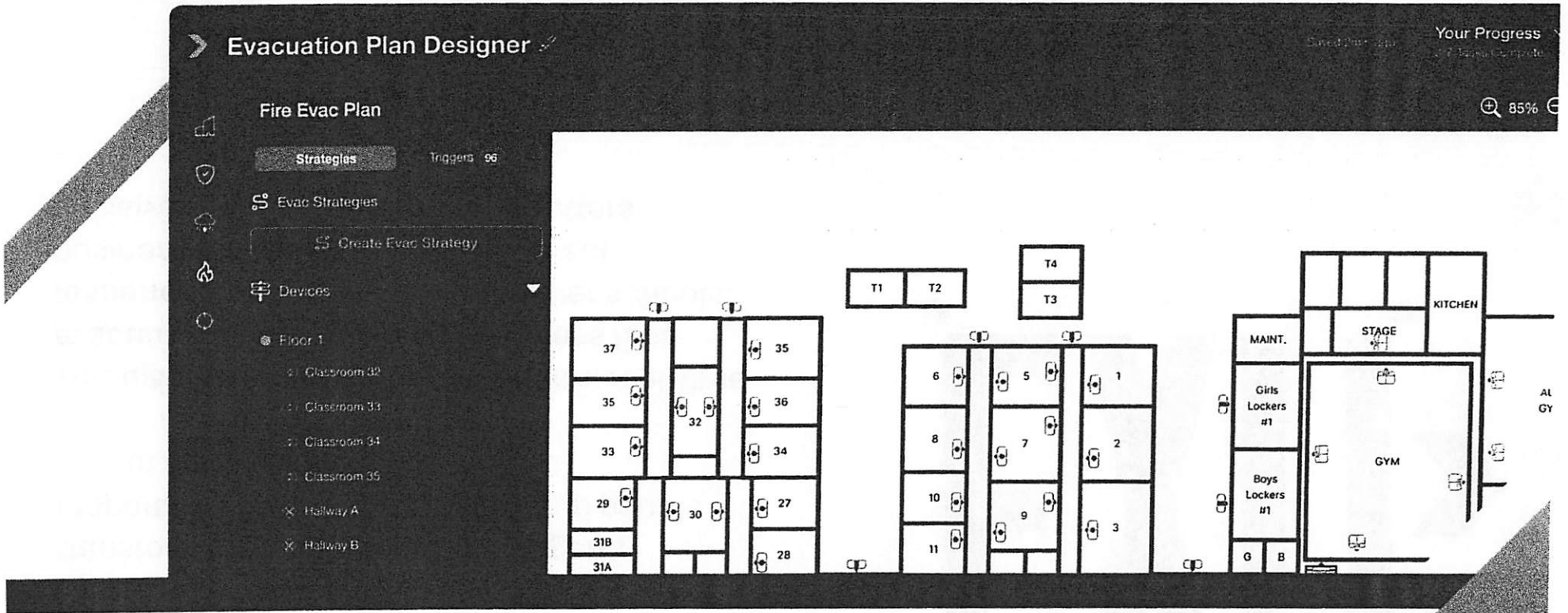

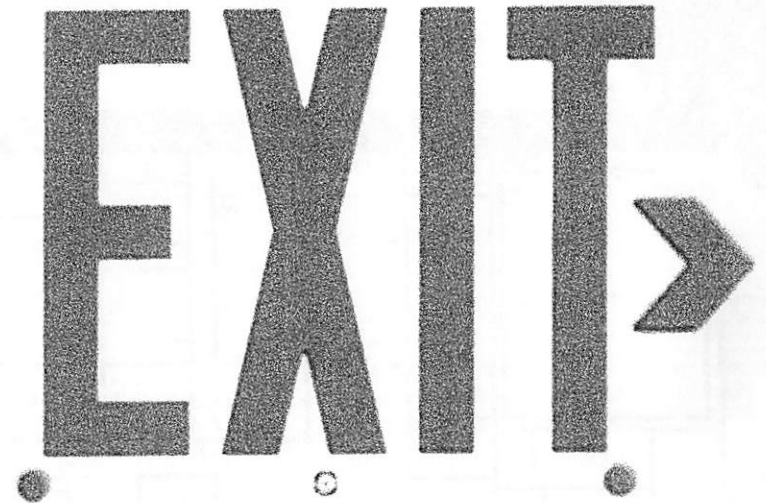

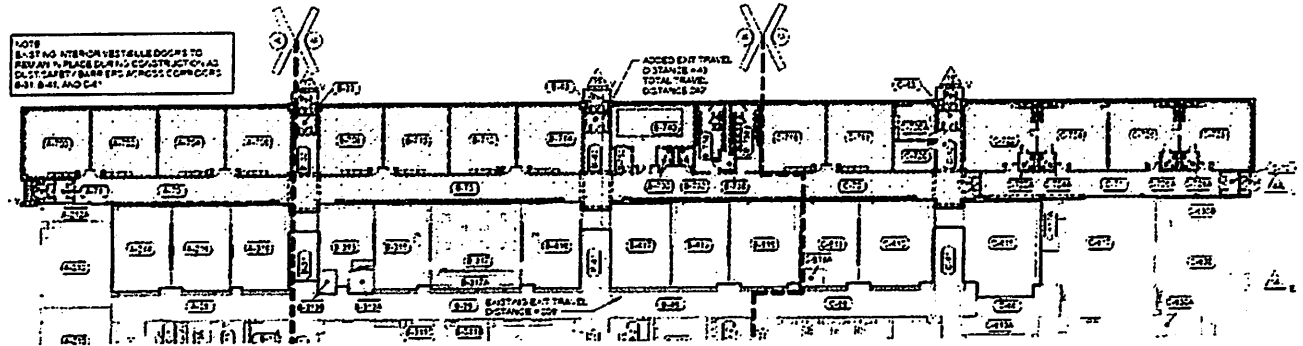


Facility Layout

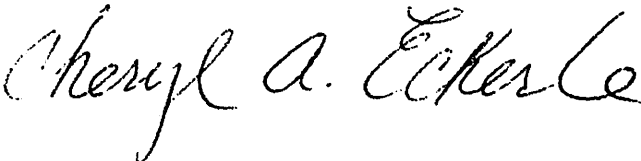
