Summer School, for the East Stroudsburg Area School District, will be held for students who failed a subject during the 25-26 school year. No student may take a course to “get ahead.” Summer school courses will be **\$100.00/course** (Out-of-district students will pay \$230 per course). Registration for summer school begins Tuesday, May 26, and will end at noon on July 10th, 2026. **No registrations will be accepted after July 10th.**

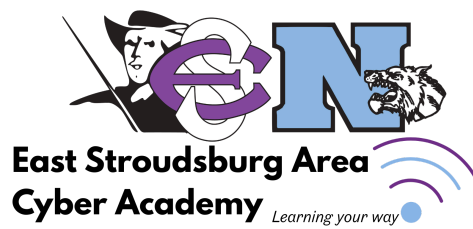
Course Dates:

All courses will begin on June 29, 2026, and must be completed on or before August 3, 2026. A student orientation meeting will be held on Monday, June 29, at 11 am. This will be a virtual orientation. This information will be included in the Welcome Email also.

Attendance:

Courses will be completed online. Students may work on the course at any time. Attendance will not be taken daily, but all required coursework must be completed by the final day. Credit and grades will be awarded based on achievement. However, student time will be reviewed through the online system to ensure appropriate time on task. Students are expected to spend approximately 10 hours a week on coursework. Students are also required to complete their assigned course(s) in its entirety.



Behavior:

All East Stroudsburg Area School District rules and regulations for computer use and student behavior will apply to the online course, including cheating and/or plagiarizing assignments. Any student violating these rules and regulations may be withdrawn from the course.

Technology / Equipment:

All students will have their school-issued Chromebooks available during the summer. Parents/Guardians will need to provide the Internet. (The public library has free Internet if needed.) Student/Teacher Communication:

Teachers will send a welcome email to all students about the summer school course. Students should expect a response to questions from teachers within 24 hours. Students should use school email to contact their instructor. Students (and families) are expected to check emails often for updates on progress in summer school classes. Families will receive daily progress updates from our learning management system, Canvas.

Grades:

The grading policy will follow the East Stroudsburg Area School District student handbook. The student’s transcript will reflect the failing grade he/she earned during the school year and the summer school grade. No extension will be granted to complete coursework. Students must complete the course fully (100%) to earn a passing grade. If students start the course and do not withdraw by the end of the 10th day (July 3, 2026), they will be awarded a grade of withdraw pass (WP) or withdraw fail (WF).
