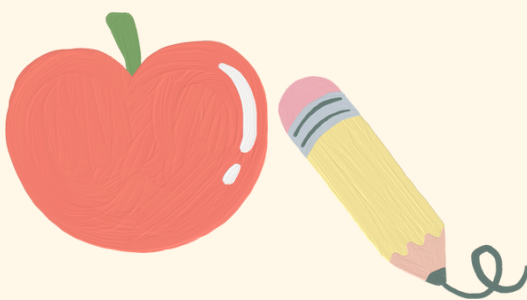
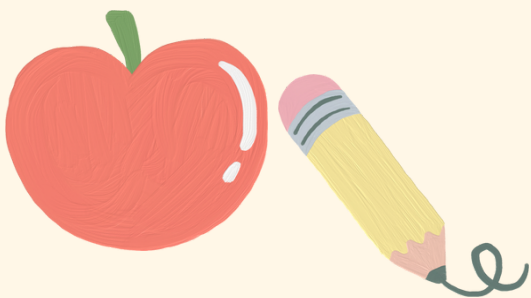




School Supply List
