

Proposition 28: Arts and Music in Schools Funding Annual Report Fiscal Year 2025-26

1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

In the 2023-2024 school year, Hacienda La Puente Unified School District hired a full time administrator for Visual and Performing Arts. The Proposition 28 expenditure plan which was launched in the 2024-2025 school year with the hiring of twelve full time elementary itinerant VAPA teachers; four in Art, Dance and Music to serve all 17 of our elementary school students in grades TK-5 including students in the SDC program. Additionally, all 2nd grade students have had an 11-week theatre arts residency. Each of the eight middle schools has had a twelve week middle school dance residency. We have also been able to hire coaches and accompanists to assist in our middle and high school arts programs and provide arts field trips for our students. We have expanded our Middle School Mariachi program to one of our high schools. This year we have expanded our arts programs by hiring more professional teaching artists as well as paying some of our current credentialed teachers to teach an additional period of Art, Drama or Music in middle school. In 2025-2026 the District launched its first ever Broadway Bound Summer Musical Theatre Conservatory Program that is open to all District students to work alongside District VAPA teachers and professional teaching artists to put on a fully produced musical theatre production by working onstage, backstage or in the orchestra. It is important to note that the summer program employs mostly District staff including 2 classified employees and 1 teaching aide from the special education department. We also launched a strings program in fourth and fifth grade that will be moving into the middle schools in the 2026-2027 school year, with an orchestra program in high school by the 2029-2030 school year.
