Superintendent Update

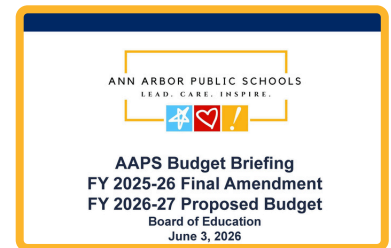

Budget Briefing

CFO Anté Britten presented for first briefing information on the final amendment to the 2025-26 budget and the proposed 2026-27 AAPS Budget.



First Briefing

Sentinel Technologies Network Infrastructure Equipment purchases in the amount of \$1,373,220 with expected in E-Rate reimbursements of \$635,000.

AP Biology Textbook Adoption purchase of 290 textbooks and 8-yr digital access to "*Campbell Biology in Focus, Fourth Edition*" from Pearson for \$73,256.

2026-27 High School Course Catalog request for approval.

Graduation Policy Updates includes requirement waivers for FAFSA and credits for eligible students.

Graduation Alliance Contract to provide dropout recovery, prevention, and re-engagement services for eligible high school students not to exceed \$526,480.

MedSPORT Athletic Training Services 26/27 contract for Huron and Skyline athletes not to exceed \$157,288.

Pediatric Therapy Associates 26/27 Contract for Speech, Physical and Occupational Therapy services not to exceed \$603,490, with expected reimbursements.

Inspired by Science 26/27 contract for Rec & Ed science enrichment youth and early childhood summer camps and after school classes up to \$142,000.

ABM Custodial Services Contract two-year extension not to exceed \$8,139,270.


Gilbane Capital Program Management Contract two-year extension not to exceed \$4,528,012.


Superior Ground Cover 5-year contract for Engineered Wood Fiber for playground surfaces in the total amount not to exceed \$612,255.
