

DISTRICT 7 ATTENDANCE POLICY

PHILOSOPHY

District 7's educational program is built on the premise that regular attendance is vital to a student's success in school. Regular school attendance is the responsibility of the parent. The student who is frequently absent misses class instruction, discussion and social interaction, even though written work is made up. District 7 has numerous resources to assist families with ensuring their children maintain regular attendance. Should parents be experiencing difficulties getting their child to attend school regularly please contact the building principal for assistance.

DEFINITIONS

Valid cause for absence - A student may be absent from school because of illness (including mental or behavioral health of the student), observance of a religious holiday, death in the immediate family, attendance at a civic event, family emergency, other situations beyond the control of the student as determined by the Board, other circumstances that cause reasonable concern to the parent/guardian for the student's mental, emotional, or physical health or safety, or other reason as approved by the Superintendent or designee.

Unexcused Absence - When a student misses school for a reason that is not considered valid it will be marked as an unexcused absence.

School staff will continually monitor the total number of absences (excused and unexcused) for each student. Staff

will reach out to families to discuss their child's absences if they are excessive and/or are having a negative impact on their child's learning. In some cases school staff may require parents to provide written verification of illness from a doctor.

Truant - A "truant" is a child subject to compulsory school attendance and who is absent without valid cause from such attendance for a school day or a portion thereof.

Chronic or Habitual Truant - A "chronic or habitual truant" is a student who is subject to compulsory school attendance and who is absent without valid cause from such attendance for five (5) percent or more of the previous one hundred eighty (180) regular attendance days.

At all District 7 schools, on days students plan to participate in after-school activities, they must be in attendance at least 1/2 day.

Riding a School Bus

Is a privilege granted by Wood Dale School District 7. With this privilege is the responsibility of proper behavior to help ensure a safe ride for all students.

While in transit, the school bus driver has complete authority over bus riders. All behavior on buses is under surveillance.

- Remember that bus drivers have authority to assign seats.
- Immediately follow all instructions given by the driver.
- Carry bus passes every day. Students must have a bus pass to ride the bus. The students should have authorization from the Bus Dispatcher for changes in routes and/or exceptions.
- Arrive at the bus stop 5 minutes prior to the scheduled pick-up time.
- Be careful in approaching the place where the bus stops. Do not move toward the bus until the bus has been brought to a complete stop and bus doors open.
- Remain seated at all times.
- Face the front of the bus at all times.
- Sit with no more than two additional riders (maximum three to a seat).
- Never pass or throw objects in the bus or from the window.
- Keep hands and head inside the bus at all times after entering and until leaving the bus.
- Refrain from loud laughing, talking or commotion that will distract the driver.
- Be absolutely quiet when approaching a railroad crossing stop, so that the driver can hear if a train is coming. (Lights and gates may not be working.)
- Never tamper with the bus or any of its equipment. Do not eat or drink or chew gum on the bus.
- Do not bring any animals on the bus.
- Keep books, packages, coats and all other objects out of the aisles & away from doors.
- Take all books, lunches or other articles when leaving the bus.
- Be courteous to the bus driver and to fellow riders.
- Do not ask the driver to stop at places other than the regular bus stop. All bus riders are to get on and off at their regular stop only. The bus driver is not permitted to make other stops except by proper authorization from a school official.
- Observe safety precautions at the discharge point. Where it is necessary to cross the highway, proceed to a point at least 10 feet in front of the



bus on the right shoulder of the highway, where traffic may be observed in both directions. Then wait for a signal from the bus driver permitting you to cross.

- Remain in the bus in the event of a road emergency until emergency instructions are given by the driver.
- Students should conduct themselves in a manner acceptable in the classroom.

Parents of bus riders should stress these rules.

In cases of infraction of the rules, the following steps will be taken:

- Suspension from riding the bus may come at any time, depending on the infraction that has taken place.
- Bus riders who have damaged the bus will be responsible for payment or replacement of damage, and may be suspended from riding the bus.

Parents of riders should ensure that their child knows the street corners of their bus stop and how to get home from there if a parent is not able to be there to pick up the child.



Kindergarten riders are required to have a parent for the student to exit the bus.

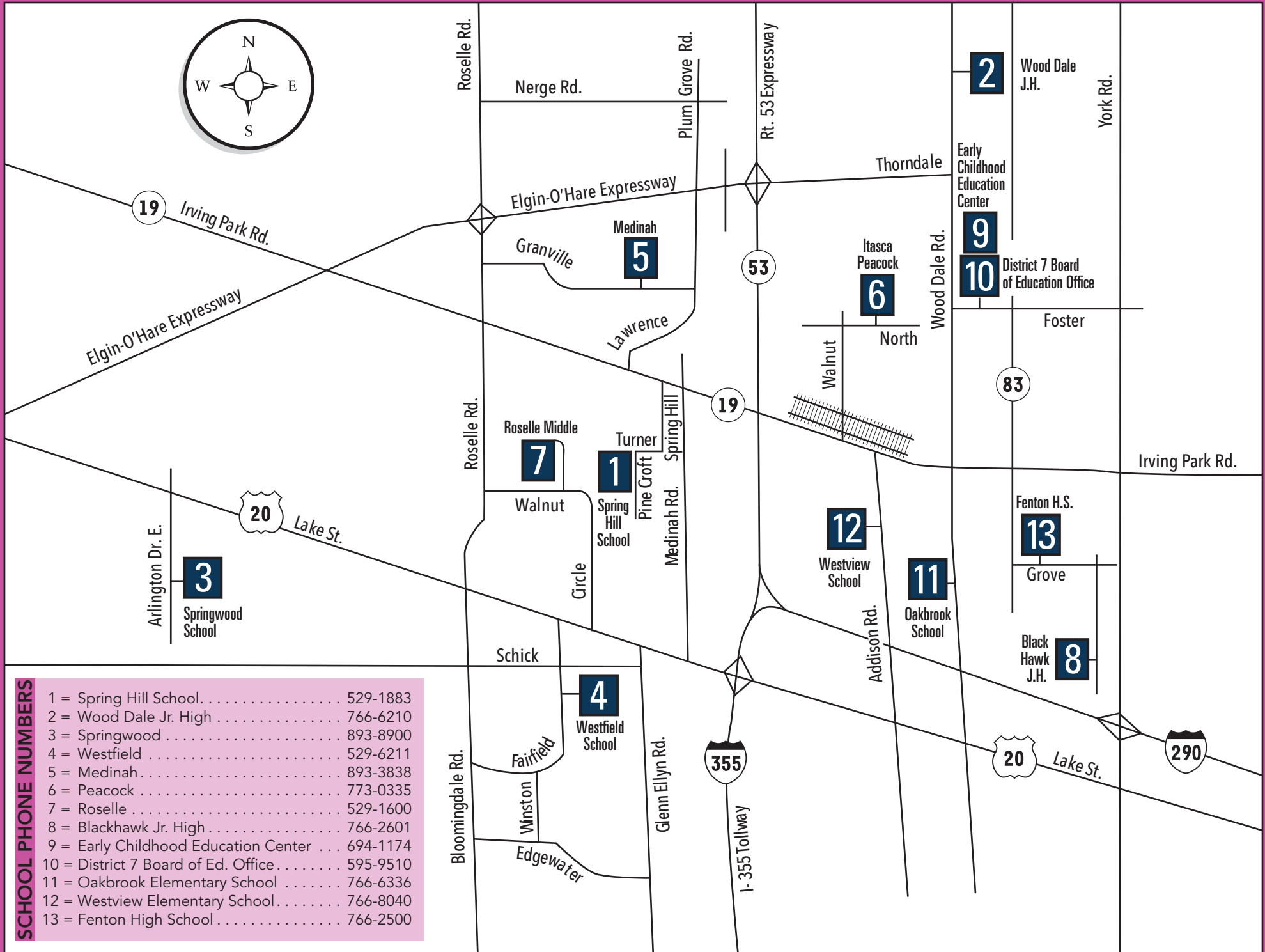
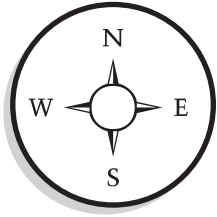
Bus passes should be easily visible to the driver. (Pinned on the backpack is the best method.) Bus passes are your child's form of identification.
