Part 3: READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY

Thousand Oaks High School provides student parking for 12th, 11th, and 10th grade students, based on space availability. Students must purchase a valid permit from TOHS each year. **Student permits are valid only in student lots.**

- Only students with a valid TOHS Parking Permit are allowed to park in student lots (Avenida de las Flores, North/A lot, and baseball lot). Students parked in any area on campus besides a designated space in a student lot may be assigned a Saturday School and may lose parking privileges.
- **NEW THIS YEAR** - Students must display the parking permit in the lower corner of the **REAR window** on the driver's side whenever parked on campus. Permit numbers must be visible at all times.
- The school assumes no responsibility for theft or damage to personal property.
- All California parking and vehicle code laws are in effect. Vehicles illegally parked are subject to citation. Students must follow all posted entrance, exit, and directional signage. Failure to follow these rules may be grounds for revoking your permit.
- Thousand Oaks High School is not responsible for lost or stolen parking passes. **REPLACEMENT PASSES WILL BE ISSUED AT FULL REPLACEMENT COST**
- If the vehicle is involved in a major accident, use the existing permit in the NEW vehicle and update the school with the new vehicle information. **REPLACEMENT PASSES WILL BE ISSUED AT FULL REPLACEMENT COST**
- Parking permit will be revoked if loaned, given, sold, or otherwise provided to another student.
- Students who have not served an assigned Saturday School (SWS) will not be issued a pass until the SWS has been served.

PARKING PRIVILEGES MAY BE REVOKED AT ANY TIME

CONSEQUENCES for violations may include the following:

1. Student and parents contacted with warning
2. Saturday School and parents contacted with warning
3. Parking pass revoked for remainder of the year

DISCIPLINE & ATTENDANCE: At school administration's discretion, students with significant or pervasive disciplinary issues may lose their parking permits.
