BHS PARKING RULES AND REGULATIONS

Parking is the garage is a privilege and not a right. The following regulations apply to all students parking vehicles on the campus.

1. All vehicles must have a BHS parking sticker in the lower passenger corner of the windshield. Each student may purchase only ONE permit. Parking permits are \$180 for the year.
2. Permits are non-transferable. They are issued to a specific vehicle and a specific student. In order to be issued a permit, the vehicle must be registered to (owned or leased by) the student or student's family. In addition, the student's name must appear on the insurance card.
3. The permit is not valid unless PERMANENTLY attached (not taped) to the lower passenger corner of the windshield.
4. In the event a student needs a replacement permit (e.g., a new vehicle, windshield is replaced, etc.) a new sticker must be purchased for \$25. Permits are non-transferable. If the old sticker appears on another student's vehicle, both students will permanently lose parking privileges at BHS.
5. Students who leave campus during school hours without permission are subject to having their parking permits revoked in addition to other disciplinary consequences
6. All vehicles parked in the garage are subject to search and seizure if deemed appropriate by school administrators.
7. Students MAY NOT park in the following locations:
 - a. Faculty parking (Level 1); visitor parking; fire, loading and unloading zones; driveways, freight lanes, entrances, and sidewalks; handicapped spots
8. Students who are illegally parked are subject to disciplinary and/or legal action, including having their parking permits revoked, being issued police citations, having their vehicles towed, and/or having a wheel lock installed. A fee of \$50 is charged to remove the wheel lock. The principal in charge of campus parking maintains a computer list of all parking violations.
9. Use or distribution of counterfeit parking permits will result in immediate revocation of parking privileges and disciplinary action.
10. Temporary parking permits must be used when not driving the vehicle that was originally registered at this school. These are available in 1720 and must be picked up BEFORE the school day begins. Arrive with enough time to place your temporary parking permit and make it to class on time. Passes will not be given allowing you to be late to class.
11. Temporary parking permits may be used on family vehicles and/or rental cars. They cannot be given to another BHS student or used in another student vehicle. Misuse of temporary parking permits may result in appropriate disciplinary action and loss of parking privileges.



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VIOLATIONS AND CONSEQUENCES

- 1st Offense – a warning sticker will be issued and 2 days of after school detention.
- 2nd Offense – a warning sticker and 1 day of ISS.
- 3rd Offense – a warning sticker, 2 days of ISS, vehicle will be towed at the owner's expense, parking privilege revoked for 30 days, and a new parking sticker must be purchased. A third parking violation may result in the loss of future parking privileges.

NOTE: Regardless of whether a valid student permit is displayed, citations will be issued for motor vehicle violations such as parking in handicap spots, fire zones, blocking sidewalks, parking on curbs, etc.
