<p>Summer Food Service Program</p> <p>Who is eligible:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Children 18 years and younger</i> 	<p>Free daily breakfast or lunch for each child: food must be eaten at meal site</p>	<p>Community Meal Sites</p>	<p>Call 211 to find a meal site near you. Registration and income verification are not required.</p>

<p>SUN Bucks</p> <p>Who is eligible:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children 6 years to 18 years who have SNAP, RI Works, Medicaid, or are eligible for free school lunch  <p>bit.ly/sunbucksRI</p>	<p>One-time payment to spend on groceries: \$120 per eligible child</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Grocery stores that accept SNAP • Farmers' markets that accept SNAP 	<p>Some children will be enrolled automatically. Money is added onto EBT*** or previous SUN Bucks card, or a SUN Bucks card is sent in the mail.</p>  <p>bit.ly/getSUNbucks</p>
<p>Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP)</p> <p>Who is eligible:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adults who are 60 and older • Adults who have a disability and are living in a housing facility that serves meals 	<p>One-time payment to spend on fruits, vegetables, and honey: \$50 per household</p>	<p>Scan card with farmer at farmers' market, farm stand, or pop-up market</p>	<p>Talk to your local senior center to pick up a card and learn more.</p>
