

Shawano Community Pool Rules

1. Absolutely no swimming without a lifeguard on duty.
2. Children under the age of 7 in the pool area must be accompanied in the water by an adult (within arms reach).
3. Children ages 7-11 must be supervised by an adult.
4. No diving in the shallow end of the pool.
5. No horseplay, running, shoving, or dunking. Behavior that endangers the safety and well-being of yourself or others will not be tolerated.
6. No breath holding competitions.
7. Spitting, spouting water, blowing your nose, or discharging bodily waste in the pool is strictly prohibited.
8. Profane language is not allowed.
9. All patrons must shower before entering the pool and after using the restroom facilities.
10. All patrons having contagious or infectious health conditions and/or open wounds will not be allowed in the pool per the discretion of the lifeguard.
11. Patrons under the influence of drugs or alcohol will not be allowed in the pool or on the grounds.
12. No smoking on school grounds.
13. No shoes on the pool deck.
14. Animals are not permitted in the pool area.
15. Glass containers and any food or drink (except for water) are not allowed in the pool area.
16. Gum, candy, alcohol, and tobacco products are prohibited in the pool area.
17. All patrons must follow the directives of and be respectful of the lifeguard or instructor in charge. Failure to do so will result in the patron being asked to leave.
18. Swimming is not permitted during thunderstorms. Swimmers will be instructed to exit the pool immediately. All water activities are suspended for 30 minutes after lightning is sighted or thunder is heard.
