Band Students:

Everyone:

1. Your instrument, **labeled with your name**

3. Band pencils. You'll need to always have one in your binder. Some students Velcro theirs into the binder :)

By Instrument:

- Flute: cleaning rod and a handkerchief
- Clarinet/Saxophone: cork grease and at least **two** boxes of reeds. Replenish your reeds as they run out. **Strength 2.5/3**. Bass clarinet: purchase tenor sax reeds.
- French Horn/Trumpet/Euphonium/Trombone: Valve and slide oil
- Percussion: a bell kit (drumsticks and mallets included) and practice pad for home use (if you bought one for SIS band, you may use the same one) **Percussionists: keep all these items at home to practice and use school equipment during band and instrument classes.**
