

6th GRADE SUPPLY LIST FOR MUSIC 6 AND PERFORMING ARTS

MUSIC 6

- A pair of headphones or earbuds **labeled with your name** in a Ziploc bag to keep in the band room at all times. We will use these a LOT, which is why I would like everyone to have a pair to keep in the classroom. They can be cheap, but they must be wired with a microphone.

Band 6

1. Your instrument, **labeled with your name**
1. 3-ring binder. Size: 1 inch. **labeled with your name and “Band”**. You do not need looseleaf. If you have yours from last year, use the same one.
2. Band pencils. You'll need to always have one in your binder. Some students velcro theirs into the binder :)
3. 1 box of tissues – give to Mrs. Malara when you see her
4. 1 container of disinfecting wipes (Clorox, Lysol, store brand, etc.) – give to Mrs. Malara when you see her.

By Instrument:

- Flute: cleaning rod and a handkerchief
- Clarinet/Saxophone: cork grease and at least **two** boxes of reeds. Replenish your reeds as they run out. **Strength 2.5**. Bass clarinet: purchase tenor sax reeds.
- French Horn/Trumpet/Euphonium/Trombone: Valve and slide oil
- Percussion: a bell kit (drumsticks and mallets included) and practice pad for home use (if you bought one for SIS band, you may use the same one) **Percussionists: keep all these items at home to practice and use school equipment during band and instrument classes.**
