Helpful Information

iPads

Each student will receive an iPad to use at both home and school. **Students must charge their iPads every night.** Students who come to school without charged iPads are not able to participate in our planned class activities.

Schoology

Schoology is used daily for posting and submitting assignments. Please check Schoology with your child to check in about homework assignments. Students are responsible for completing all assignments. Please note directions and due dates to help prioritize and complete assignments.

Grades

Please sign up for Sapphire, the online Parent Portal for grade monitoring. This allows you to access your child's grades anytime. Your child will also have a student log-in to check their grades. Pick a day each week to review your child's grades with them. There are four marking periods in a school year. Report cards are issued at the end of each marking period and interims are sent home in the middle of each marking period.

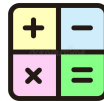
