

5202 Stock Epinephrine

The District may acquire, maintain, and dispense to schools within the District a supply of epinephrine for emergency use, including auto-injectors, nasal sprays, or any other approved device or method authorized by law. The school nurse and/or other trained staff members may administer stock epinephrine to a student whom the school nurse or trained personnel in good faith believes is experiencing a severe allergic reaction.

The District will implement a plan consistent with current guidelines and the plan will be made available on the District's website.
