Social-Emotional & Whole-Child Wellness



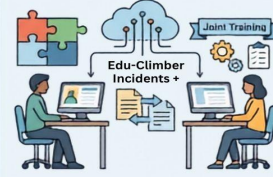

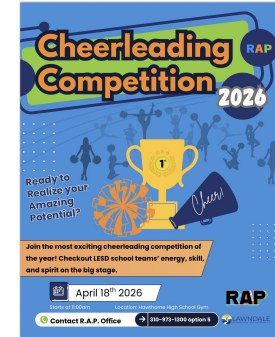
Cheer
