Campus Arrival Food Policy

To maintain a focused and orderly learning environment, we are implementing an updated food and drink policy regarding student arrivals:

Students arriving after 8:30 AM will not be allowed to bring outside food or beverages onto campus. Students arriving before 8:30 AM may bring items such as Starbucks or Coffee Bean; however, teachers may set their own classroom policies regarding drinks. Any confiscated food or beverages will be held in the office until the end of the school day.

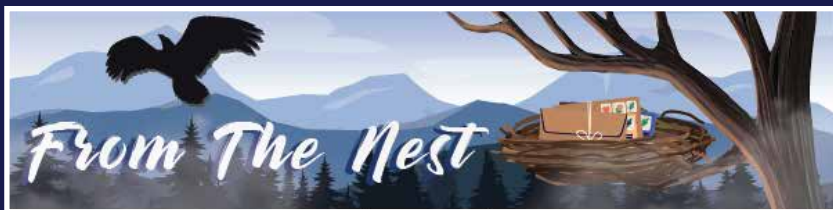

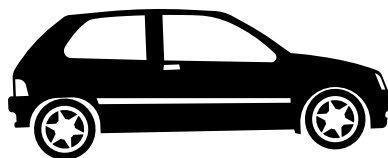

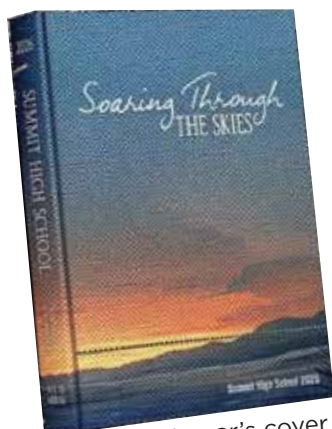

Buyer finally understands that the student must satisfy the Dance/Event Contract in order to attend school dances and events. This means the student's school account must be paid in full prior to any release of dance tickets (including any club charges and/or library fines), student's attendance record must be satisfactory (example: no more than 10 day absences for any reason), and the student must not have any severe disciplinary infractions (example: fighting, weapons, drugs/alcohol, etc.).
