HOW WILL THE BOARD FILL THE VACANCY FOR DISTRICT ONE?

TO APPLY

- **Verify eligibility** by reviewing the Ector County ISD Eligibility Requirements for School Board Members (*see page 2*)
- Complete and submit your resume.
- Along with your resume, provide a **cover letter** that addresses the following:
 - *Why do you want to become a member of the ECISD Board of Trustees?*
 - *What particular experiences or skills have prepared you to serve as a Trustee and contribute positively?*
 - *Please describe the ways you have been of service to the community.*
 - *Please provide your vision for public education in our community.*
 - *The term for District 1 expires in May 2027. Are you interested in running for election in May 2027?*

NEXT STEPS FOR THE ECISD BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Trustees will accept applications from **07/01/2026 – 08/14/2026** and will discuss and select candidates to interview at the **ECISD Board of Trustees Meeting on August 18, 2026**. Selected candidates will be notified thereafter with details of the interview process.

The Board of Trustees will hold a **Special Meeting during the week of August 31, 2026** to interview selected candidates and potentially take action to fulfill the District 1 Board position.

ECTOR COUNTY ISD — ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR SCHOOL BOARD MEMBERS

To be eligible to serve as a member of the ECISD Board of Trustees, a candidate must meet the following requirements:

- Be a United States citizen. *Election Code §141.001(a)(1)*
- Be 18 years of age or older on the first day of the term to be filled at the election or on the date of appointment, as applicable. *Election Code §141.001(a)(2)*
- Have not been determined by a final judgment of a court exercising probate jurisdiction to be totally mentally incapacitated or partially mentally incapacitated without the right to vote. *Election Code §141.001(a)(3)*
- Have not been convicted of a felony. *Election Code §141.001(a)(4)*
- Have resided continuously in the state for 12 months and in the territory from which the office is elected for six months immediately preceding the following date: *Election Code §141.001(a)(5)*
 - For an independent candidate, the date of the regular filing deadline for a candidate's application for a place on the ballot.
 - For a write-in candidate, the date of the election at which the candidate's name is written in.
 - For an appointee to an office, the date the appointment is made.
- Be registered to vote in the territory from which the office is elected on the date described in item 5 above. *Election Code §141.001(a)(6)*
- A candidate for trustee representing a single-member trustee district must be a resident of the district the candidate seeks to represent. *Education Code §11.052(g)*
- Must be a qualified voter. *Education Code §11.061(b)*
