

**SPARTANBURG COUNTY DISTRICT FOUR
PUBLIC HEARING FOR 2026-2027 BUDGET AND
BOARD MEETING**

The District Four Board of Trustees held a special public hearing and meeting on Thursday, June 25, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. to consider the 2026-2027 budgets. This meeting was advertised and open to the public. Having no public comments or statements, the Public Hearing was adjourned.

Chairman Smith called the meeting to order.

Chairman Smith stated that the purpose of the meeting was to consider the 2026-2027 budgets for Spartanburg County District Four Schools, R.D. Anderson Applied Technology Center, McCarthy-Teszler and the Spartanburg County Alternative School. Mr. Benfield reviewed the executive summary in the District Four budget and the Debt Service Budget.

Board Action

1. Approved the 2026-2027 budgets for Spartanburg School District Four General Fund, District Four Debt Service Fund, R.D. Anderson Applied Technology Center, McCarthy-Teszler, and the Spartanburg County Alternative School.
2. Approved a resolution for all Spartanburg District Four Schools to continue to participate in the Community Eligibility Program for the 2026-2027 school year.
3. Approved the bid for hospital beds for use in the Health Science classes at WHS from Southern Education Systems for \$60,535.80.
4. Approved the bid from Y&S Technology in the amount of \$87,085.35 for technology carts to be used at WPS, WES, and WIS.
5. Approved Parent Teacher Organization officers for Woodruff Intermediate School for the 2026-2027 school year.
6. Approved the following personnel for the 2026-2027 school year:
