

Supplies and Expectations for 8th Grade Science, Math, Social Studies and Language Arts:

Each student must have these items at school in every class, every day, for the entire year. Please label every item clearly with a permanent marker.

Language Arts:

- ☐ 1 3-ring binder (1 inch to 2-inch size)
 - *Folders are not allowed!*
- ☐ 3 single-subject spiral notebooks
- ☐ 1 pack of loose-leaf paper
- ☐ 150-200 index cards
- ☐ 2 different colored highlighters
- ☐ Pens, pencils, highlighter, and colored pens

Social Studies:

- ☐ 1 3-ring binder (1 inch to 2-inch size), with loose leaf notebook paper (no folders)
- ☐ 1 spiral notebook, 100 pages minimum (plastic cover recommended)
- ☐ Pencils, highlighter, and colored pens
- ☐ 4 Glue Sticks

Geometry

- ☐ 1 folder
- ☐ 1 compass
- ☐ 1 protractor
- ☐ 1 ruler (6" or 12")
- ☐ 1 stack of Index Cards (3x5)
- ☐ Pencils, highlighter, and colored pens/pencils

Science

- ☐ 3 composition notebooks, 100 pages minimum (these are often available on sale during the summer from Staples, Office Depot, and Wal-Mart)
- ☐ 1 Graphing notebook (available in stationary isle of Wal-Mart, Staples, Office Depot)
- ☐ 1 folder
- ☐ 8 glue sticks
- ☐ 8 rolls of tape
- ☐ 1 stack of Post-it Notes
- ☐ 1 box of tissues
- ☐ Pencils, erasers highlighter, and colored pens

For All Classes

- ☐ 2 boxes of tissues
- ☐ Zipper pencil case (to fit in binders)
- ☐ Pens: blue and/or black ink
- ☐ Pens: colored ink (for editing written work)
- ☐ Pencils and erasers
- ☐ **WIRED** headphones (no Blue Tooth allowed)

In addition to the above, the following supplies should be kept at home for projects and other assignments:

- Markers, Crayons, and Colored Pencils
- Tape and Glue
- Construction Paper
- Index Cards
- Graph Paper
- Calculator
- Ruler
- Poster Board
- Dictionary and Thesaurus
- Library Card
