Motion to approve the April minutes by Crystal. Seconded by Megan. Motion passed.

1. Budget Review
 - a. STEM kits were ordered and delivered to MS students. Families left great reviews about them.
 - b. Shipping has been difficult for the books for K-5 students. Books were delivered in time to be sent home with student bags for 4th and 5th grade students. Still waiting on a delivery for books for grades K-3, but hoping to have them mailed out yet this week.
 - c. It was discussed and agreed to spend the remaining money on the following items:
 - i. Gifts for graduating Title VI students
 1. A small group will discuss options through local artists (print, lanyard, card, t-shirt, etc.)
 2. Planning for 40 students, but Kelley will check on number of students graduating
 - ii. STEM kits for Brener students
 - iii. A banner congratulating Shawano graduates from the PAC committee using our logo
 - iv. More books for HC classrooms with any leftover funds
 - v. Motion to approve this plan made by Starlyn, seconded by Drew. Motion passed.
2. Program Updates
 - a. STEM kits have been delivered with raving reviews.
 - b. Still working on books for K-5 students
 - c. Check-ins from staff are going well.
3. Grant Application Update
 - a. June 19th is still the current deadline
4. Public Hearing Preparations
 - a. Invites for the hearing were sent out to Tribal offices.

- b. Looking into objectives for next year - Kelley will send out a Google Form to Title VI families looking for input on top 5 objectives so we can narrow down and vote on them at the public hearing. A small group will meet prior to the public hearing to go over survey results.
- c. Keeping in mind that we can only spend money on things tied to our objectives, possible ones to consider that were discussed: at-risk supports, college/career readiness (field trips an college tours), academic achievement, cultural activities
