Senior Painted Parking Space Option

Seniors may show their Panther Pride by painting their parking space. To be eligible, seniors must first purchase a Senior Paint parking pass for \$60.00. An application must be filled out by the senior prior to painting the parking space with the exact artwork/color scheme design that they wish to get approved. No senior parking spot may be painted until the application is submitted and approved. **Seniors are the only students who have the option to personalize a parking space.**

Process

1. Complete the application for personalizing your parking space and submit the form for approval.
2. Purchase a student parking pass/paint permit for \$60.00 through central office and receive your assigned parking space for the school year.
3. Once you receive approval for your parking space design, purchase your paint and supplies using the suggestions Material Guide listed below. Note: some of these items are optional and may not be needed. You may find it helpful to share with your classmates to save money and resources.
4. Show up during the assigned dates/times to personalize your parking space.
5. At the end of the school year, paint over the design in black exterior all weather, water-based paint provided by the school system.

Material Guide

- Students must purchase their own resources to personalize their parking space.
- **Paint must be exterior all weather, water-based paint.**
- We suggest that you talk to the paint department about your design and the surface you will be painting so they can help you decide what is best to use and how much paint to purchase.

Other Resources that may be helpful:

- Paint Brushes or Rollers (be sure to have plenty for each color and/or cleaner for your brushes between colors)
- Paint Roller Extension Pole (optional — this can expedite the process of painting the background color without needing to bend down)
- Paint Can Opener, Paint Stir Sticks, Paint Trays
- Paint Tape
- Broom (to sweep off space prior to painting)
- Chalk (to draw an outline of what you want to paint)
- Stencils (optional — can be helpful if you don't want to free-hand your illustration)
- Cloths, Towels, News Paper, Cardboard (to help with cleaning, placing materials, and sitting/kneeling while painting)
- Trash Bags

These resources are NOT permitted

- Oil-Based Paints
- Raised Paint
- Spray Paint or Paint Sprayers
- Glitter or Textured Paint
- Reflective Paints

- Clear Coat or Sealants

Parking Space Design Proposal

- All designs and color schemes must be submitted with a completed application to Superintendent Miller at central office (email: jmiller@glascock.k12.ga.us) no later than July 15th for final approval.
- Applications will be reviewed by administration. If there are questions about the design or it is not approved, the student will be contacted for clarification and or suggestions.
- All decisions are final and may not be challenged.
- Only students with application/designs that have final approval will be permitted to personalize their space during the assigned dates/times. Students may not add additional artwork or make changes to the artwork or color scheme at any time while personalizing their space or throughout the school year without permission from Mrs. Miller.
- Original copies of approved plans and a photo of the completed artwork will be kept on file and monitored throughout the school year.
- Students that alter approved plans may lose the privilege to have a personalized space.
- Additional disciplinary action may result depending on the nature of the offense.

Painting Days

- The dates/times for painting parking spots must be scheduled with Mrs. Miller.
- Students must check in with supervising staff members prior to painting.
- Staff will verify that students have an approved application, design, and fees paid, and appropriate paint supplies.
- Only correctly labeled paint may be used.
- Students may help one another if it is requested.
- All painting must be completed during the allotted dates/times provided unless approved otherwise by Mrs. Miller due to special situations that may require extended time.

Permitted

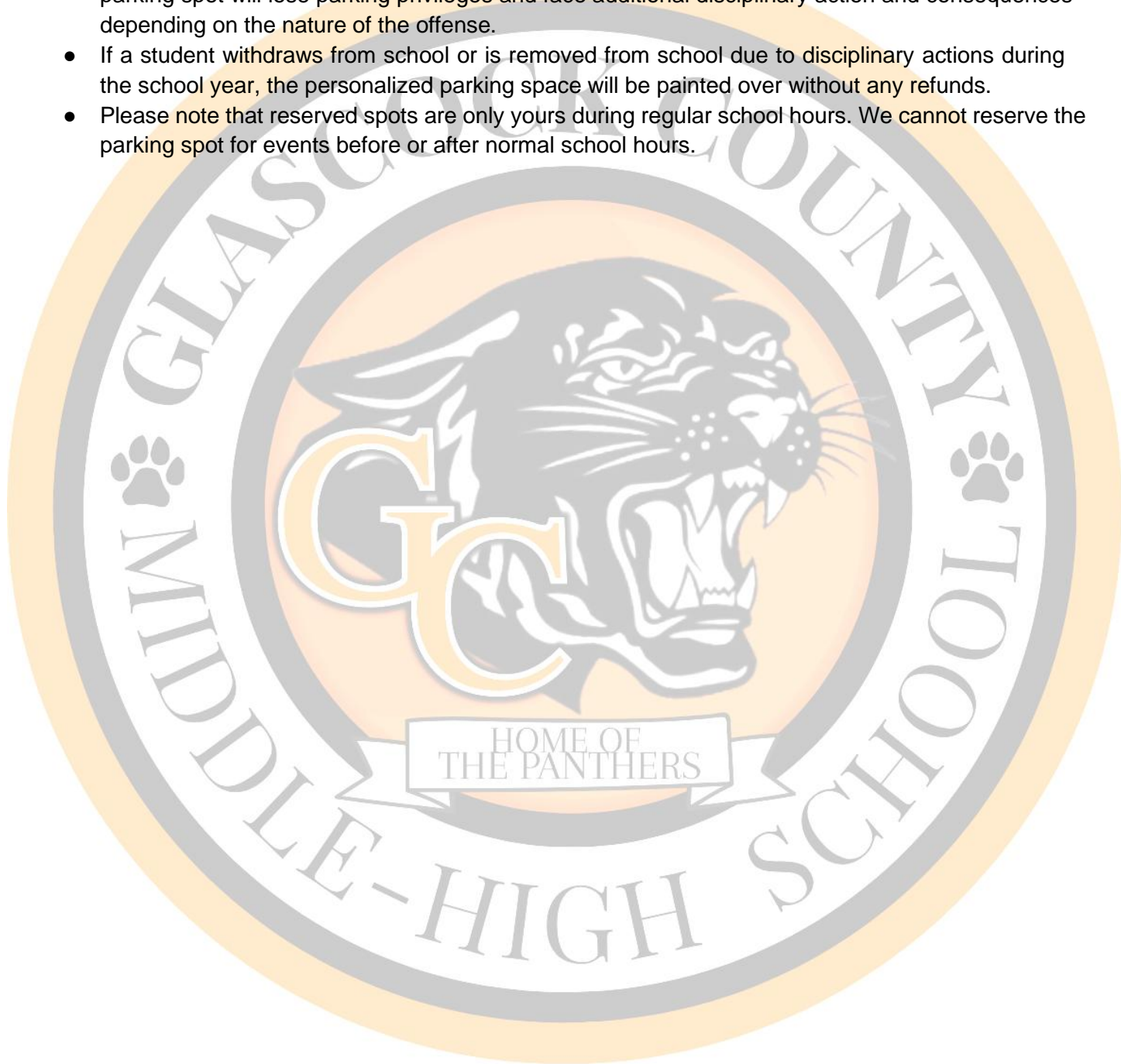
- School Themes
- School Spirit
- GCCS Sports/Clubs
- Your Personal Name, initials, or nickname
- Show your school spirit and depict the highlights of your high school experiences
- Your design must be school and public appropriate
- You can include images of sports, jerseys, cheers, the official school logo, etc.

Not Permitted

- Any design that shames others such as race, gender, religion, etc...
- Offensive Language, Pictures, or Symbols
- Negative or Rude Language
- Political Statements
- No name other than your own, initials, or nicknames
- Any personal information that the school district is not permitted to publicly share or release about the student
- References to drugs, alcohol, smoking, gangs, or other inappropriate behaviors
- No advertisements for a business or a product
- No reference to another school's mascot, logo, or name

Other Information

- Painted parking spot designs will not exceed the length or width of the painted parking lines.
- Students will not paint on the white parking lines in any way. All designs must be painted within 12-inch border of the parking space.
- No refunds will be provided after the parking space has been painted.
- Any student in any grade level that paints a parking spot without permission or vandalizes a senior parking spot will lose parking privileges and face additional disciplinary action and consequences depending on the nature of the offense.
- If a student withdraws from school or is removed from school due to disciplinary actions during the school year, the personalized parking space will be painted over without any refunds.
- Please note that reserved spots are only yours during regular school hours. We cannot reserve the parking spot for events before or after normal school hours.
