KINDERGARTEN READINESS SCREENING - JULY 1ST OR JULY 14TH

Please go to: <https://www.signupgenius.com/go/70A0848AAA62BA0FF2-64401210-kindergarten#/> to sign up for ONE 20 minute slot on either day (whatever suits you best) to bring your child in to be screened. You will need to bring your Driver's License and scan it at the front entrance of the school to be buzzed into the school. You will wait up front in the front office while your child is walked back to the library to be screened. Please prepare your child that you cannot go back with them for the screening process. The screening will be done by one of our Kindergarten teachers. This is not necessarily the teacher your child will have for the 2026-27 school year.



KINDERGARTEN POP-IN - JULY 16TH 5:00-7:00 PM

This is a new opportunity we are offering for this year's rising Kindergarten students. You will walk your students into our cafeteria where they will be matched to a Kindergarten teacher (not necessarily theirs). They will get to go back to the classroom for an hour to do a craft, an activity, and a fun game with the PE teacher. This gives them the chance to separate from parents, and for us to see them interact. We will have a program in the cafeteria for the parents while the students are in the classrooms, ending with playground time together!



KINDERGARTEN ORIENTATION - AUG 11TH @ 3:30 PM

Come in the main doors and drop off your child in their classroom (class lists will be posted on the bulletin boards outside of Kindergarten, but it's best if you can remember your child's teacher). Parents will report to our Forum area for orientation while your children take their first school bus ride. We ask all students to participate in this bus ride event if they will be car riders this year. All students will ride a bus on field trips, and it is a great practice! After the orientation, you will go pick up your child, and drop off all of their supplies. The supply list is found on the Penn Forest website. This is also the county-wide back-to-school night for elementary schools, so we will welcome our returning students later in the day. After you leave the Kindergarten area, you will report to the cafeteria for car rider signs (if needed), to join the PTA, get a picture in the photo booth (if desired), complete any remaining first day forms, and add money to lunch accounts if needed.
