4. Superintendent's Report

A. Solution Tree National PLC Cohort

Dr. Kiser presented to the board information about a five year program with Solution Tree PLC National Cohort. Professional Learning Communities are part of the MTSS process. This process will focus on improving Tier I instructional practices. The cost for the program is \$66,100 annually and is a five-year program, for a total cost of \$330,500. C. Perfect Attendance Incentives

The Superintendent recommends the board approve perfect attendance incentives for certified and classified staff that are school-based employees and bus drivers for the 2026-2027 school year.

Details are as follows:

Certified staff receive \$200 per semester for perfect attendance (no sick or personal leave used) or \$500 for perfect attendance for the entire school year.

Classified staff receive \$100 per semester for perfect attendance (no sick or personal leave used) or \$250 for perfect attendance for the entire school year.

This applies only to school-based employees and bus drivers. Comp time does not factor into attendance for this incentive. Vacation days taken during student instructional days will disqualify employees from receiving the incentive.
