Ms. Ramsey moved to appoint A. Michael Roberts to fill the School Board Director Vacancy left by David Okonski's resignation, term ending in 2027.

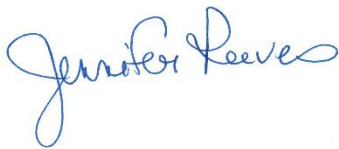
A roll call vote of the Board resulted in the following vote:
