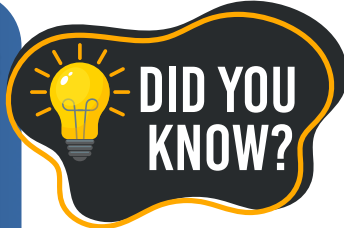

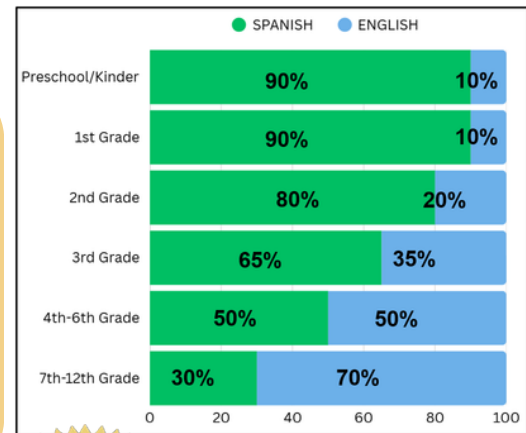
- **51.5%** of English Learners scored on/above grade level on i-Ready Diagnostic 2. That is 17.6% higher than English only classrooms!

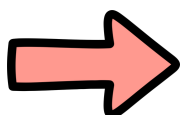
