

## **BACK TO SCHOOL NIGHTS**

Each West Fargo Public Schools' building hosts a two-hour event prior to the first scheduled day of school. While all elementary and middle school learners must be accompanied by an adult throughout the event; parents are also encouraged to attend with their high school learners.

The purpose of this event is to:

- Provide an opportunity for educators to greet learners and families
- Allow learners and families to visit their assigned classroom
- Allow learners to understand the layout of the building
- Allow learners to bring their school supplies

In addition to the primary objectives outlined above, these events also provide avenues for district partnership organizations to promote their available opportunities for students.

- Scouts
- YMCA

Private businesses, entities, clubs, etc. do not have access to families during Back-to-School night unless contracted or hired by the school district to promote family engagement.

This two-hour time is contracted for educator participation in lieu of time within the regularly scheduled contract day, as guided by district leadership.
