LEARNER PARKING & PERSONAL MEANS OF TRANSPORTATION

- Middle school learners are not allowed to drive or park on school property. In addition to standard motor vehicles, this prohibition applies to all types of off-road motorized vehicles, including but not limited to ATVs, UTVs, and snowmobiles. Hoverboards and any electric scooter-like devices are not allowed on school property.
- Bicycles, skateboards, rollerblades, motorized or otherwise should only be used for riding to and from school and will not be accessed during the school day. They are not the responsibility of the school.
 - Bicycles or other wheeled items will be parked and locked by the learner on the provided bike rack.
 - Wheeled items are not allowed on school buses.
 - If the building principal allows, skateboards, rollerblades, scooters, etc. may be stored in a safe place in collaboration with the teacher during school, potentially placed in their locker, or locked in the bike rack outside.

In the event a high school learner is attending class at a middle school campus, the learner is allowed to drive their standard motor vehicle to school, provided they have a valid driver's license, and park in the designated learner parking spots.
