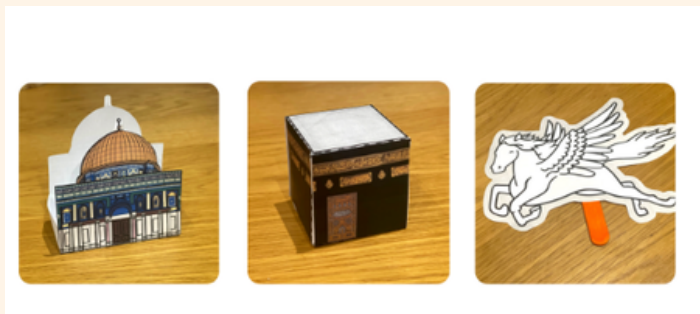
Parents' Message

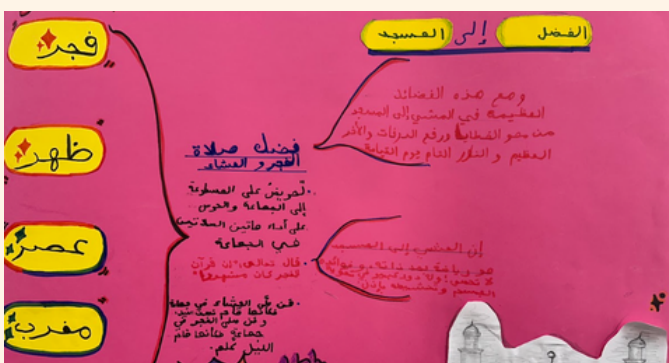
Students' Projects - Primary
