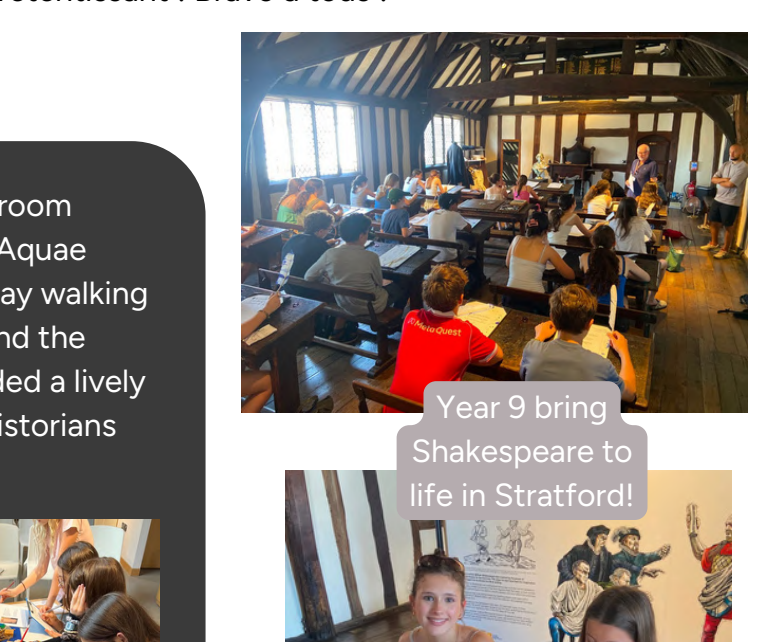
Beijing provided Year 9 Mandarin learners with an extraordinary opportunity to extend their learning far beyond the classroom.



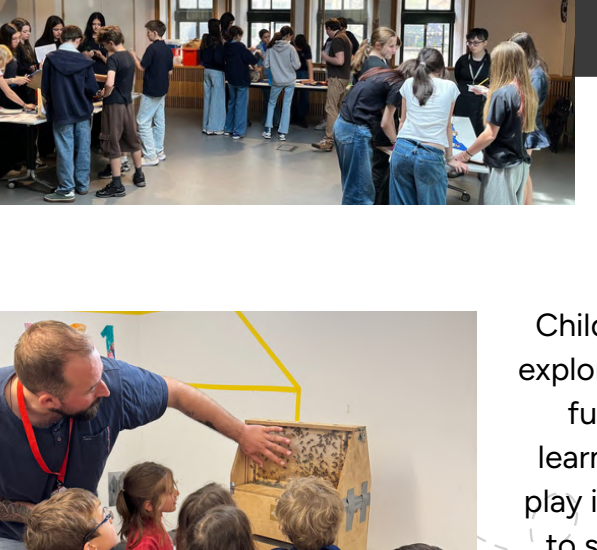

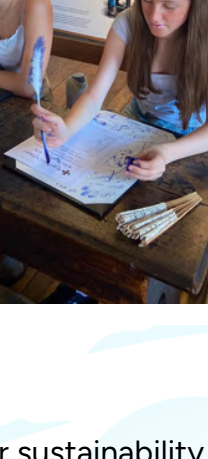
Year 4 brought history to life with a visit to Rochester Castle and the Guildhall Museum

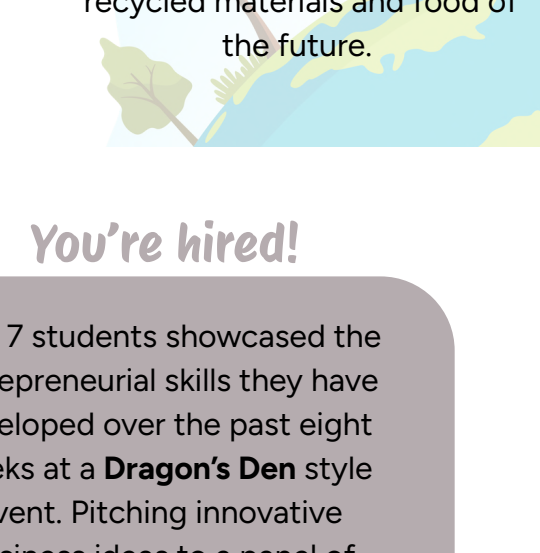


Exploring Life in Roman Britain

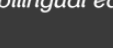


10 Year celebration!
