

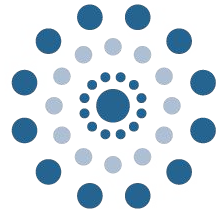

# Student Contract

# Student Contract 1, 5: College Life Starts Now

You're not just a high schooler; you're a college student. This means adult content in classes and being around older students.

You are subject to three behavioral & academic policies, and codes of conduct: Home district, OHM BOCES & MVCC.

# Student Contract 2, 13: Pre-Set Pathways

The classes you take are part of a specific plan to get your degree. You don't get to pick *any* class you want. You have to meet the requirements and work with our college coaches.

All scheduling and course selection goes through P-TECH.

# Student Contract 3, 5, 8: Stay in Good Standing

If you're failing classes at high school OR college, there will be consequences. Academic probation, meetings, tutoring, schedule changes, and maybe even removal from the program are *all on the table*.

# Student Contract 1, 4: College Grades Matter (Big Time!)

The grades you earn at college are real and permanent. They're on your MVCC transcript forever. MVCC's rules apply to you just like any other college student.

P-TECH cannot change your grades at the college level.

# Student Contract 6, 7, 14: Attendance is Key

MVCC and P-TECH attendance policies are strict. Three unexcused absences could mean being dropped from a class *without notice*. Lateness counts, too!

Follow the check-in/check-out procedures. Poor attendance can get you sent back to high school.

Attend when high school is closed.

# Student Contract 9: Textbooks are Provided (but need to be returned)

P-TECH pays for your books and all *required* course materials. You need to return them in good condition. Lose or damage them? You pay for the replacements.

# Student Contract 11: Driving? Permission Required

Home district will provide transportation. If you are driving, you need to pay for a parking pass at MVCC.

No transporting other students, ever!

# Student Contract 12, 13, 19: Communication is Key

As a college student, you are expected to check and answer emails regularly on both your BOCES and MVCC accounts.

Help is available but you need to communicate your needs!

P-TECH staff is always your first point of contact, including for your parents.

# Student Contract 17: Diploma vs. Associate Degree

Earning your high school diploma does not guarantee the associate degree. You have to meet all of the college program requirements.

# Student Contract 10, 18: Be Responsible on Campus

With great privilege, comes great responsibility!

No leaving campus during school day.

Go to the dorms = Bye, bye P-TECH!

College coaching meetings are mandatory.

Member of three communities.

Academic integrity a must!
