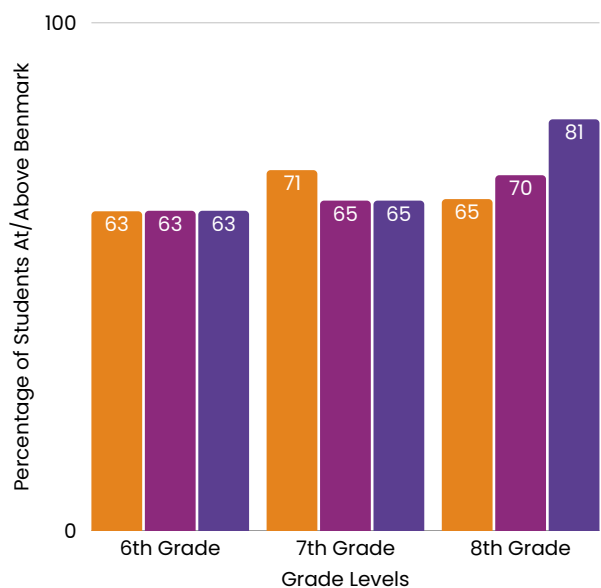
SIP - ACADEMIC GOAL
